AppleScript




What is AppleScript?

- Built into Mac OS X
- Used to control existing applications
- Automates time consuming and repetitive tasks



Writing Scripts


- Script Editor
 - Located in "Applications > AppleScript" folder





Scriptable Applications

- Applications must support AppleScript
- Scriptable Applications include an AppleScript dictionary
- Level of AppleScript support may vary from application to application






Viewing Application Dictionaries

- Launch Script Editor
- Select "Open Dictionary" from "File" menu
- Locate and select desired application
- Library palette provides quick dictionary access for commonly used applications



- Create Slideshows

iPhoto

- Batch Process and Convert Images
- Import and Export Images
- Assign Comments and Keywords
- Trigger Photoshop Actions
- Integrate with Other Applications



iTunes

- Import Tracks
- Adding and Extracting Track Information
- Manage Playlists
- Generate CD Inserts
