### 1.2 What for ...

---

So here we are...

ComDizZ is a litte AREXX script for DirectoryOpus Version 4. Version 5 is out now but has not been much tested by me in the last days...

So this script doesn't work for Version 5 :-)

(read the

Requirements

) for more infos!

So what is this script for?

ComDizZ will extract the FILE\_ID.DIZ information of any file in one of your archives

My little script will now do the following:

The DIZ will be compressed and all useless ASCII is removed. Only plain readable chars will still remain and data will be written to the File-Comment of your file. SnatchDIZ © by rASCAL/SUPREME is used to extract DIZ. It supports LHA-, LZX-, ZIP-, DMS-, EXE-, GIF- and TXT-Files! All you have to do is to highlight an object in dOPUS, press button and a stripped COMMENT will show up in a requester. Then you'll have the possibility to edit the COMMENT and after pressing return it will be added to your file.

When there is NO File\_ID.DIZ you are asked to paint one with DIZ-Ed!

Eazy, eh?

### 1.3 Not that hard...

I guess everybody who knows dOPUS has already inserted a selfedited button...

First copy c/ files to c: , REXX/ files to REXX:  
It's too easy... but I guess you already did it!

So all you have to do is to make a button with a link to my AREXX script.

## 1.4 You got this crap...

- an AMIGA w/Kick 2.04+
- the lha-, lzx-, UNzip-, DIZ-Ed-executable placed in your path. Unzip, DIZ-Ed, SnatchDiz are in this archive!
- The original CLI-Commands DATE,DELETE,FILENOTE, SORT,LIST and the SNATCHDIZ-executable in your C: path (the system files should already be there ( C: ), where they belong to!)
- for sure AREXX
- DirectoryOpus 4+ (sorry - with Version 5 it doesn't work yet) (searching for someone who makes it work with 5!) (contact me and I send you the READABLE sourcecode!) (or just do it, release it but mention me!)
- a copy of ComDizZ in your REXX: path
- just a second time to edit a button in DOPUS!

- V1.0: 01.April'95 - Never been released... just a working beta  
 Based upon a bad programmed AREXX-Script I downloaded once somewhere...  
 - It's no APRILSCHERZ!
- V2.0: 15.April'95 - Never been released too...  
 - Added error-handling  
 - Added advanced stripping of bad chars  
 - Added editing option
- V3.0: 25.April'95 - meanwhile Commodore was sold to Escom ;-)  
 - First Release!  
 - Added Multifileselection  
 - Added requester  
 - Added DizMagIc-Script for non-interactive use!
- V3.1: 27.April'95 - Fixed problem with Directoy scans!  
 Errorhandling:Now a requester opens when you try to scan a whole directory!  
 - Fixed a problem with locale-handling  
 - Highered the limit of chars from 70 to 79  
 - Advanced stripping of bad chars again  
 - Added the function to scroll after entrys

- 
- V3.2: 28.April '95 - Added the function to break during work  
(press both mousebuttons to BREAK!)  
- Cleared code a bit  
- Fixed the handling bug! Now I use the original  
CLI-command FILENOTE for inserting the comments  
in your files. The internal dOPUS-command made  
some problems in handling files l8er...  
- Removed DizZMagIc from archive!  
Now the INTERACTIVE & NONINTERACTIVE version

To switch this function off give the argument  
"NODIZED" after the "INTERACTIVE" option!  
- If you want to have DIZ-Ed on dOPUS-screen then  
go to its PREFERENCES screen and enter the  
SCREEN -> FRONTMOST mode!  
- NEW OPTION: MAKELIST  
When starting with "ComDizZ MAKELIST"  
a sorted file will be created with name  
and comment in a row in your actual dir!  
This is useful for people who want to spread  
lists of their Up/Download dirs to friends  
who should know what is in the archives!

Filenames that include ILLEGAL Chars (such as \*,=)

- V3.6 16.June '95 - How drunk was I? I came back from NEXUS7 (sux!)

- Files with spaces weren't handled correctly  
 in 3.5! SnatchDiz has an error. Now a requester  
 will popup to inform you that you have to rename  
 the files!
- optimized the code (espacially the loops!)  
 now it's a little faster...
- found a bug in localization! When not using ENGLISH-  
 catalog the ERROR-requester was faulty!  
 Should work now!
- Yep Gandalf... I haven't found any solution for YOUR  
 problem yet... probably the error is gone now ?!

V3.7 21.June '95 - Now ComDizZ works with more then one DOPUS-Rexx-Port,  
 so multitasking is is now enabled! :-)  
 - Added a simple "beep on error" !  
 - Added a little infowindow that shows up while  
 working (grin!)  
 - due to the optimizing it is slightly faster again!  
 - now after editing the fileid with DizEd ComDizZ will  
 request for editing the comment. You don't have  
 to start the script again on the edited file!  
 - thisone seems to be the last version...  
 if you want something in here or I see bugreports  
 i'll bring out a 4.0 with new features!

V3.8 19.July '95 - all people that installed the BETA should install  
 ALL files AGAIN !!!  
 - Never thought there would be a NEXT release! ^^  
 - Update of SnatchDiz 2.2 ©'95 rascAL/shooT is  
 distributed in the package!  
 Because of that ComDizZ handles files with SPACES!  
 yep... that took a long time :-)  
 - Now ComDizZ is much faster !!! Snatchdiz 2.2's new  
 feature is that you can make it resident!  
 Copy the new Version to your C:  
 DELETE, FILENOTE, SNATCHDIZ - All this files HAVE

 80 chars! But remember that only the first 80  
 will be written to the filecomment!
- Advanced stripping of bad chars again

- Statusline is repaired to show allways the right file at the right time!
- Won't do a Dopus5 Version yet... nobody seems to be interested in this tool, cause of no replys... Now start to mail me sucker... I wanna know who uses this bigshit! ;-)

V3.9 06.August '95- Some incredible NEW enhancements: Thanx to Gandalf/PHN for the ideas!

If you are downloading new files and you want to ComDizZ'em immediatly you HAD the problem, that you probably don't know which files were NEW!

But now you can choose the new option DATECHECK! DATECHECK will remember the last time you used ComDizZ (files !CD1DIR will be created in your path) and will then automatically SELECT the latest files and progress them! You need the file DATE in a path! (edit the preferences... see last updatepoint!)

The first time you start this option all files in the chosen dir will be selected (files >01.01.1978!)

By the way, I never had this problem Gandalf had, because I use one window that is sorted by time, so I can see which files are new... Nobody needs that anymore :-)

By the way... does anybody need this REXX-Script ??? Nobody (except Gandalf) gave me a feedback... and not a feet in my back!

Now it's Saturday morning 05:03 and I start to feel a little tired though...

- A yap, I forgot to say that another bug is fixed. The CR's in the File\_ID.Diz weren't converted correctly that sometimes 2 words wouldn't have a space in between them... This is gone and everything is readable now!
- Fixed a bug... NODIZED didn't work well but will now!
- Preferences ADDED! Just load the script in an editor and edit the PREFERENCES part to your system needs!
