\* What is Stereo Crypter ?

Stereo Crypter is a program made to crypt and hide your datas in old stereograms pictures.

\* But, what is a stereogram ?

A stereogram is a picture hidden in another picture. You must squint to see the hidden picture. But, this is only the theory. In the facts, it's very hard to see these pictures. So why not to hide datas instead of a picture. That's the idea of Stereo Crypter.

\* Overview of Stereo Crypter.

Stereo Crypter was made in AMOS Pro v2.0. So, that's why it's not a wonderful workbench program with buttons, checkmarks, sliders ... The interface is graphically very poor (inspired by MS-DOS, you see!?)

It is composed by a menu in text mode + a stereogram view when crypting/decrypting.
