To manually install the Corel Quattro Pro Macros Help,

9 Click the Standard Help Files component box.

10 Click OK until you get to the Custom Installation dialog, then click Next.

11 Click Install to install the Corel Quattro Pro Macros Help.

Corel WordPerfect Draw Macros Help

The Corel WordPerfect Draw Macros Help (wpdrmhushelp) no longer ships and is not installed since the macros used in Corel WordPerfect Draw are a subset of those used in Corel Presentations.

Corel PerfectScript Programming Commands Macros Help

The Corel PerfectScript Programming Commands Macros Help (psmh80en.hlp) might not be installed. The Corel PerfectScript Programming Commands Macros Help requires approximately 552KB of disk space. It is automatically installed when any product using Corel PerfectScript macro capability is installed (such as Corel WordPerfect). It is also available under a custom CD-ROM installation.

Because you may have to exit the Macro Command Center before you can install the Macros Help, right-click this help topic, then click Copy or Print Topic to use these instructions.

To manually install the Corel PerfectScript Programming Commands Macros Help,

- 1** Run the Corel WordPerfect Suite 8 Setup program from the CD-ROM.

 - ▶ Corel WordPerfect Suite 8 Setup.
- 2** Click Next, then click Yes to accept the terms of the License Agreement, if necessary.
Fill in the registration information in the Registration Information dialog, if you want.
- 3** Click Next to get to the Installation Type dialog, then select Custom as the Installation Type.
- 4** Click Next to get to the Choose Destination dialog, then indicate the destination drive where you wish to install, if necessary.
- 5** Click Next to get to the Custom Installation dialog.
- 6** Click Selection Options, click Deselect all, then click OK.
- 7** Highlight (but do not checkmark) the Required Components component, then click Components.
- 8** Highlight (but do not checkmark) the PerfectFit component, then click Components.
- 9** Click the PerfectScript component box.
Note that when you select the PerfectScript component, other components will be selected automatically, which you may but do not need to deselect.
If you deselect other components, click Yes to any messages verifying you want to deselect a component. Use the scroll bar to make sure you have deselected all the other components.
- 10** Click OK until you get to the Custom Installation dialog, then click Next.
- 11** Click Install to install the Corel PerfectScript Programming Commands Macros Help.
