"Full Company Name" refers to the full legal name of your company or organization. "Short Company Name" refers to an abbreviation or acronym under which your company or organization may be known. For instance, the organization "International Business Machines" is also known as "IBM". MARKETbuilder allows you to include both names so that customers find you quickly and easily no matter which name they use.

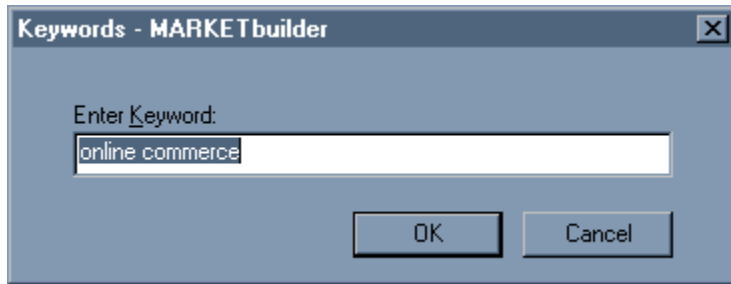
The industry category listbox contains the industry classifications currently recognized by MARKETbuilder. Select the category here that best describes your company. This information may be used in a 'yellow pages' search.

Marketing Identity

The marketing identity screen allows you to provide a logo, a slogan (or 'mission statement'), and some text describing your company. Supplying a logo ensures that customers will easily recognize you, and the company slogan will leave a lasting impression with your customers. This information will be displayed on the front page of your site, and will be one of the first things that visitors to your site will see.

Browsing for the company logo graphic invokes a dialog box that allows you to select a graphics file. Depending on the size and type of your graphics file, MARKETbuilder may resize and convert the content of the original file into a web browser compatible format, and write the output to a new file. Your original file will not be changed in this process.

Marketing Content

The marketing content screen allows you to define up to 10 key marketing messages about your company. These messages will be grouped under a title. You can select a pre-defined title or create your own title for these messages.

Each message consists of a headline and a text body that can be created and edited in a separate dialog box. As a guideline, each key message should be made up of a single sentence that summarizes an important marketing statement (the 'headline'), and a paragraph that embellishes on this statement (the 'body text').

Catalog Screen

The catalog screen displays a list of all entries. For your convenience, you can sort the items by price, item name, or description by clicking on the column headers. However, the catalog entries will always appear on your web site sorted by pricing category (promotional items first), followed by item name (in alphabetical order).

In the catalog item dialog, you describe goods and services you may want to advertise or offer on your web site. Each entry consists of an item name, a short description of the product or service, pricing information, and an optional picture or graphics file.

A small icon (depicting a 'P' or 'R') to the left of each entry indicates whether you selected regular price or promotional price to be displayed for that item and that the item is available for on-line ordering. If no icon is displayed, you have no price displayed on the site and customers must contact you via conventional methods (phone, fax, etc.).

Depending on your company's activities, the title 'catalog' may not be appropriate for display on your web site. You can change the title by selecting one of the suggested titles in the drop-down box or you can create your own title (e.g. "Millenium Deals") by writing into the selection box.

Clicking on the 'Add' and 'Modify' buttons opens a dialog box for creating and editing catalog entries. Mandatory fields for each new catalog item are item name, description, category (product or service) and currency definition. You can select the pricing category for each item (i.e. whether you want to display no price at all (inquiries only), the regular price (e.g. list price), or the promotional price (with regular price as reference) by clicking on the radio buttons for these categories.

The 'Preview' function will display the appearance of your web site in detail (using your template and color scheme selections).

Submission Screen

The submission screen prompts you to specify your host information and displays the results of your submission.

If you are submitting your site to Maximizer BusinessNet, the upload mechanism will prompt first-time users for their user ID, password and destination directory (which will be used to build a unique URL or web address). Users who are already registered will provide a user ID and password in a login dialog.

If you are submitting your site to another ISP, you will be prompted for the necessary login information (user ID, password, server, and directory). Please contact your service provider for this information and record it for future reference.

MARKETbuilder will inform you about the progress of the upload, including when the upload is successfully completed.

If there was a problem during the transfer of your site's information, this screen will suggest a course of action or a method for contacting technical support.

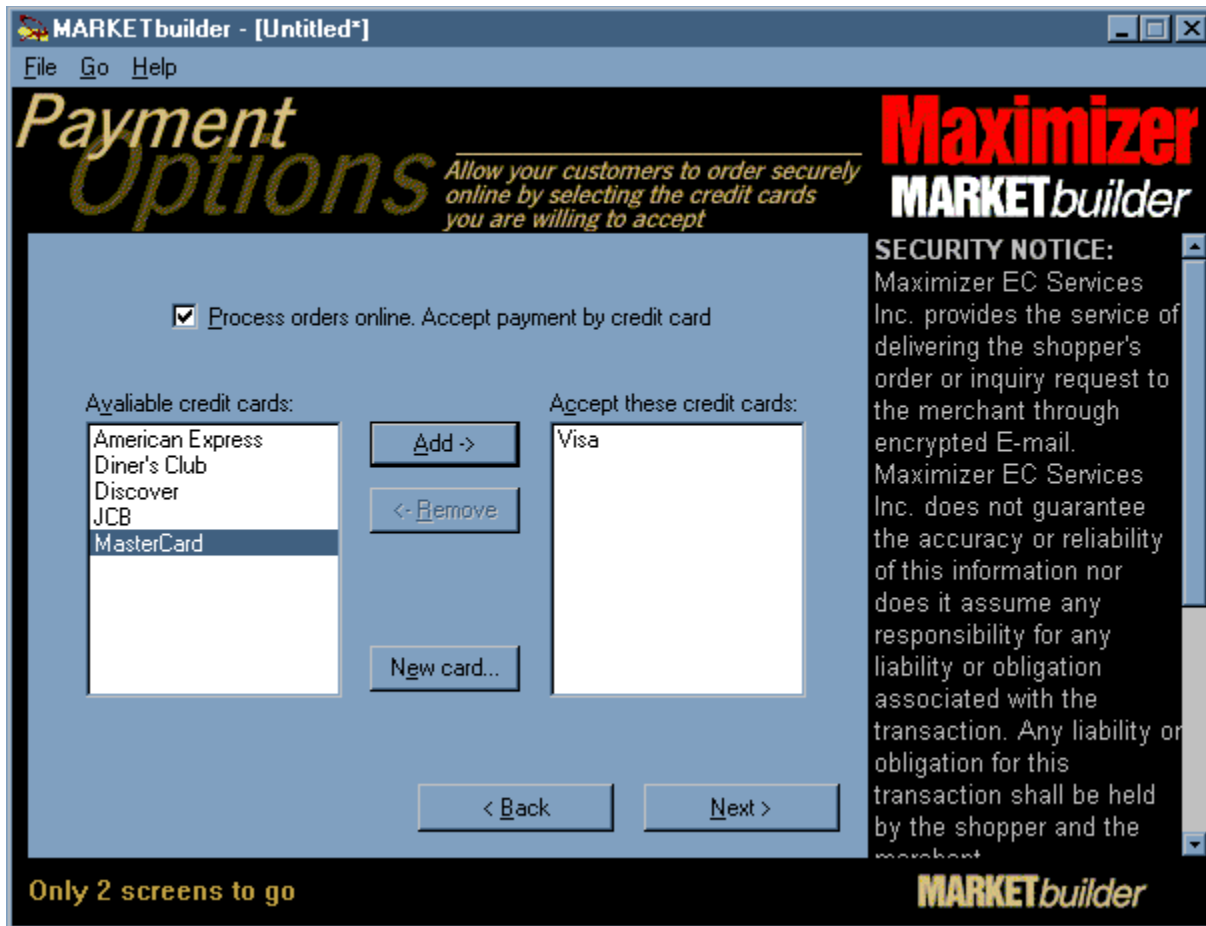

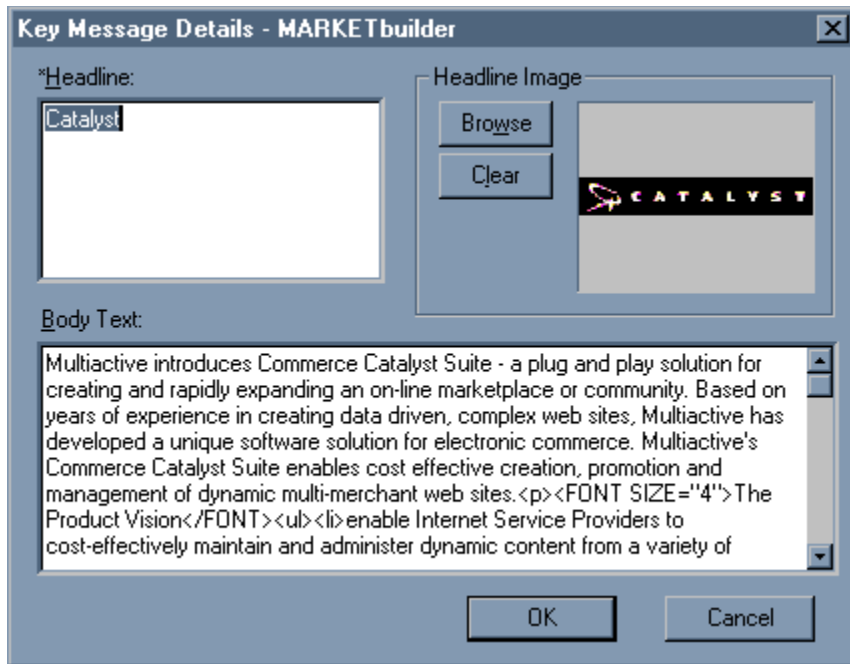

Select this option to save your current web site to a local file folder. The site will be exported in HTML format. This can be useful if you may need to perform further processing.

For example, some users may need to send this information to a co-worker via email. Others may need to further edit the content with a special HTML editor.

Save your web site to a file folder

There are situations in which FTP may not be the best method for transferring your generated HTML files to your host. For instance, if you are running your own Web Server, it may be more convenient if you can save your files directly into your local directory. Another possible reason is that your ISP may be using a proprietary protocol for file transfer.

This feature will save the entire generated web site into a directory you specify. Once the files are saved, you can transfer them to the host server through whatever mechanism that is most convenient.

This option can be selected from the Files menu or from the submission page.
