You dodge just in time to avoid a pileup, but two other drivers aren't so lucky.... With seven laps to go, you downshift just before the entrance to the hairpin before the Start/Finish line, but you've come in too fast. Tires scream as the g-forces pull your car to the right, and the wall looms close. All you can do is hang on and pray that you squeeze by-at 200 miles and hour, kissing the wall is not something you want to do....

Daytona\_ USA brings the excitement of stock car racing action from the arcade to the armchair! Play the Arcade version of the game, or check out the extra options in Sega's special Saturn Mode.

Strap yourself in behind the controls, and get ready to race!





## **⋘**Beginner



This is a smooth, fast course that can be driven mostly at flat-out speeds. The final hairpin before the Start/Finish line can make or break your race. This is also the only course where you begin the race from a rolling start. Fight your way from last place to first!





Rolling terrain, high walls and a long tunnel reduce the visibility of this course and make the sharpness of the turns less predictable. Pre-race practice is recommended.



Converted from city streets and highways, this course takes on a whole new dimension when racing. Sharp hairpin curves, varied course widths and low visibility make competing on this circuit a real challenge.





The Starting Line (Starting the Game)



Press the Skip Button2jump\_new in the Title Screen to access the Mode Select Screen. Choose modes with the <u>Selection Button</u>, and confirm with the Confirmation Button or the <u>Skip Button</u>.





#### Arcade Mode

Play the Daytona USA game straight from the arcades! Choose one of three courses and one of two cars. A Time Attack Mode is available. Please see <u>Arcade Mode for details</u>.

#### **PC** Mode

Play the special PC version with extra options! Choose one of three courses and one of four cars. A Time Attack Mode is available as well as a special Mirror Mode.

Please see PC Mode for details.

#### Ranking Mode

See the top times for each mode, course and type of transmission. Please see Ranking Mode for details.





In Arcade Mode, you race both against your rivals and against the clock. You start the race with an allotted number of seconds on the timer, and receive extra time (the amount depending on the race and course chosen) each time you pass beneath a Checkpoint. If your time runs out before you pass beneath a Checkpoint of the Start/Finish line, the game

Select Arcade on the Mode Select Screen to access the Arcade Mode. Both the standard mode and a special Time Attack Mode are available.

The Circuit Select Screen appears when you select the PC Mode. Choose one of three courses: Beginner, Intermediate, or Expert.

# **Ranking Mode**

View the top racing times for each game mode and course. Select a game mode by pressing the <u>Selection Button</u> UP or DOWN, and select a course within that mode by pressing LEFT or RIGHT. Access the rankings for the selected mode and course by pressing the <u>Skip</u> or <u>Confirm</u> <u>Button</u>.

Scroll through the rankings by pressing the <u>Selection Button</u> UP or DOWN. Return to the Ranking Selection Screen by pressing the <u>Skip Button</u> or <u>Confirm Button</u>. To go from the Ranking Selection Screen to the Mode Select Screen, select EXIT and press the <u>Confirm Button</u>.

#### **Circuit Select Screen**



**Arcade Mode, PC Mode:** Select the Beginner, Intermediate or Expert course by pressing the <u>Selection Button</u> LEFT or RIGHT. To choose the course, press the <u>Confirm Button</u> before the countdown reaches zero. (When the countdown reaches zero, the highlighted course will be selected and you automatically go to the Mission Select Screen. To cancel course selections and return to the Title screen, press the <u>Cancel Button</u>.

#### Circuit Description

In PC Mode access the Mirror Mode feature by holding the <u>Skip Button2</u> while choosing your course.

#### **Mission Select Screen**



**Arcade Mode:** Choose the type of transmission you want to use. Press the <u>Selection Button</u> LEFT or RIGHT to select an Automatic or 4-speed Manual transmission. Choose by pressing the <u>Confirm Button</u> before the countdown reaches zero. (When the countdown reaches zero, the highlighted transmission is selected and the game begins.) To access the Time Attack Mode, hold the <u>Skip Button2</u> while choosing your transmission.

Cancel your choices and return to the Circuit Select Screen by pressing the Cancel Button.

**PC Mode:** Choose one of four different cars before the timer runs out. To access the Time Attack Mode, hold the <a href="Skip Button2">Skip Button2</a> while choosing your car.

Return to the <u>Circuit Select Screen</u> by pressing the <u>Cancel Button</u>.



#### **Time Attack**

Use Time Attack Mode to practice your driving techniques, familiarize yourself with a course, or try for a lap record. In Arcade Mode, you can compete with the countdown as well just you against the timer!



Select either Arcade or PC Mode and choose a circuit. When the <u>Mission Select screen</u> appears, press and hold the <u>Skip Button2</u>.



A stopwatch icon appears above the course at the bottom of the screen. While holding the <u>Skip Button2</u>, press the <u>Confirm Button</u> to select your car/transmission and enter the Time Attack Mode.





# **Options Screen**



Change the game settings and sample the music used in the game. In the Options screen, press the <u>Selection Button</u> UP or DOWN to choose an option, and LEFT or RIGHT to alter features within the option.

**Game Mode:** Alter the number of laps of each race, depending on the length of the course chosen.

**Difficulty:** Select a difficulty level. The harder the game, the fewer seconds you get to complete a race in Arcade Mode.

**Enemy Level:** How fast do you want your competitors to be? Choose from VERY EASY to VERY HARD.

**Music Test and Sound Test:** Sample the music and sound effects used in Daytona USA. Press the <u>Selection Button</u> LEFT or RIGHT to select a track. Press the <u>Confirm Button</u> to play the music or sound effect.

**Key Assign:** Configure your game controls. To enter the Key Configuration screen, select KEY ASSIGN and press the <u>Confirm Button</u>. Press the <u>Selection Button</u> LEFT or RIGHT to cycle through the four preset Control Pad Settings (Type A is default), and press the <u>Confirm Button</u> to select and return to the Option screen.

To customize your game controls, press the D-Pad LEFT or RIGHT until EDIT appears on screen, then press Start. All of the control labels will begin to blink.



### 5-0 The Finish Line





The times and initials of the top 20 drivers appear on the Ranking and Title screens. There are two ways to get your name listed: by scoring the fastest overall time or the fastest single lap. You don't have to finish a race to make a fastest lap. If you made both a fastest lap and a fastest overall time, you only enter your initials once they appear on both records.

If you burned in a record-setting time, the Enter Initials screen appears after you finish your race. Press the <u>Selection Button</u> LEFT or RIGHT to cycle through the letters, and press the <u>Confirm Button</u> to enter a letter in the first space and continue to the next. To go back a space, press the <u>Cancel Button</u>, or select the arrow and press the <u>Confirm Button</u>.

Exit the Enter Initials screen by pressing the <u>Skip Button</u>, by making entries in all three spaces, or by selecting END and pressing the <u>Confirm Button</u>.







Control, rather than flat-out speed, gives you the fastest lap times.



Hitting or rubbing against the wall robs you of precious seconds more than anything else.





Keep your car moving in a uniform direction, with smooth, even lange changes and turns. Watch the other cars at first and learn the best places to enter and exit each corner.



Take advantage of the Time Attack Mode to familiarize yourself with every aspect of a circuit.



If you are using a Sega Saturn Control Pad or PC Pad, keep a light touch on the D-Pad. Unnecessary swerving costs valuable time, and if you're using a manual transmission, you increase your chances of shifting into the wrong gear by accidentally pressing the D-Pad UP or DOWN.





## The Menu and Removing the Software

#### Using the Menu and Removing the Software

The following are directions on how to use the Menu and how to uninstall the game. **Press F10 to bring up the menu bar**.



In the Menu bar you'll find three sub menus: Game, Option and Help. Click on these menus for the following:

**Game:** Lets you start or quit a game. See **Game Details**.

**Option:** Lets you change game options. See <u>**Option Details**</u>.

**Help:** Click HELP to bring up a pull-down menu leading to the Help

File.See **How to Use Help**.



Software Removal

Click REMOVE on the Install screen, or uninstall from the system.



Do not load the installation program while playing the game.





Click GAME during gameplay to see the following:

Restart Game... (Alt + R)
Start the game from the beginning.

Exit Game... (Alt + F4)

Quit the game.





From the Menu bar, click OPTION to see the following:

#### **Change Control:**

Allows you to select input devices and assign key and button functions. Select the input device you wish to use from among any compatible devices currently connected to your PC. To calibrate an analog input device, select JOYSTICK from the Control Panel.

#### **Change Display Mode:**

Set the screen output to high- or low-resolution. If the game seems to be moving slowly, try playing in low-resolution. (This will only have an effect if your board and driver are Direct X2 compatible.)

#### **Change Disp Size:**

Change the size of the game screen. Choosing a smaller screen increases the speed of the game. (This is only effective if the display is set to highresolution.)

# **Clip Size:**

Choose from three levels of visibility NORMAL, WIDE or VAST. The higher visibility levels may slow the game down.

#### **Motion:**

Choose SMOOTH or ROUGH for the game motion. SMOOTH motion may slow the game down. ROUGH motion will make the game run faster, but the action will appear jerkier.

### **Background Display:**

Switch the background display ON or OFF. If the game seems to be running too slowly, try playing with the background display switched OFF.

# **See Through:**

Allows you to choose PolyLine for the background display. You can increase the game speed by choosing PolyLine and switching the background display OFF.





Clicking on Help in the Menu brings up a pull down menu with a list of options. Click on the option you want information about. You can also call up the Help feature by pressing F3.




