Hello, just a little note to tell you about these NewIcons style icons, for the Amiga's two best Word Processors, Wordworth and Final Writer.

1.2 ?i

Firstly, you must have the incredibly good NewIcons installed correctly. If you do not have NewIcons, it can be found on the Aminet.

Next, open a shell window.

Now, you need to use InjectBrush, so type:

```
"InjectBrush <Path of Wordworth/FWriter Icon>.info <Path of this  
WordIcons directory and the appropriate "a.br" brush> <Path of this  
WordIcons directory and the appropriate "b.br" brush> FORCE
```

and press [RETURN].

If that was a little unclear (which it will be unless you have a very high IQ indeed :-), then here are 4 examples.

- 1) "InjectBrush Work:Wordworth5SE/Wordworth.info RAM:WordIcons/WW5SEa.br
RAM:WordIcons/WW5SEb.br FORCE"
- 2) "InjectBrush df0:Wordworth.info RAM:WordIcons/WW3a.br RAM:WordIcons/
WW3b.br FORCE"
- 3) "InjectBrush Work:FWriter5Lite/FinalWriter.info RAM:WordIcons/
FW5LITEa.br RAM:WordIcons/FW5LITEb.br FORCE"
- 4) "InjectBrush df0:FinalWriter.info RAM:WordIcons/FW4a.br RAM:WordIcons/
FW4b.br FORCE"

You MUST add the FORCE command at the end of the line, because, as you will see, the icons are quite a lot bigger than standard NewIcons. I made them this size, simply because they look better. They are designed for a HiRes Interlaced screen mode. They all use the standard NewIcons palette.

By the way, the WW4SE brushes are for the WordWorth that came with the Amiga Magic pack.

1.3 ?w

I made these NewIcons for two reasons.

- 1) I don't know what FWriter's icons are like, but WWorth5SE's icon was a good example of how it is almost impossible to make a nice icon in just 4 colours. I'm not having a go at Digita here: The only decent 4 colour icon I have seen yet is the Aminet CD 13 icon !
(well done Urben Muller :-)
- 2) I was incredibly bored and just wanted something, anything, to do.

If you like these icons then that's just great. I'm not asking you to send me a postcard or anything for them, because I think that even a 26p stamp is too much for these icons! However, if you want me to expand this set of icons, then please feel free to send me your suggestions for further icons.

If you want to make your own NewIcons in this style, then have a look at the pictures "WW.iff", "WWSE.iff", "FW.iff", and "FWLITE.iff". These contain all of the brushes (apart from "WW4SE.br") and some templates for the backgrounds of the icons.

You may also have noticed the brushes for versions 6 of FWriter/WWorth. These aren't out yet, but I am thinking ahead you see. So, when they are released you can replace their 4 colour icons with my nice NewIcons icons. If anyone from Digita/SoftWood is reading this then have a look at

Hello there. If someone from Digita is reading, then thanks for the excellent Wordworth5SE. If someone from SoftWood is reading, then I'm sorry for choosing WW but I like the Workbench look, and the compatibility with Magic Menu. It was very close though.

Anyway, to get to the point, if you want to use my Wordworth6 or the FinalWriter6 icons, then you can do this if you send me a little message to tell me this, and you include a small credit in the package (a note to say that "The NewIcon icon was made by Richard Martin" at the end of the installation script would do.)

You can send the message to my address.

Note that you will still have to design a 4 colour icon, as NewIcons (available on the Aminet) is very different to the MWB style icons: If the user does not use NewIcons he/she will still see the old icon.
