

Netscape Navigator 2.0 Java Beta 1

This beta version of Netscape Navigator will expire on Mar. 15, 1996.

Netscape Navigator 2.0 Java Beta 1 is available for PowerMacs only.

Release notes for this version of Netscape Navigator are available online.

After starting the program, select "Release Notes" from the "Help" (Balloon Help or AppleGuide) menu.

To submit bugs, use the "How To Give Feedback" option, also on the "Help" menu, which will take you to the URL:

Installation Instructions

Installation Steps:

1) Download the .Hqx file to your Macintosh. If you are using Netscape to do the download and your machine is correctly configured, Netscape will automatically run the correct program to decode the .Hqx file. If not, you will need to use one of the many utilities which can decode .Hqx files (Binhex format), we recommend something in the StuffIt family of products, such as "StuffIt Expander"

2) To install Netscape Navigator 2.0 Java Beta 1, double click the installer.

a) Click "Install" to place a binary of Netscape Navigator 2.0 Java Beta 1 on your hard drive. This will also install a Java folder within the Netscape preferences folder. This folder contains files needed for Java to run on your Macintosh.

3) Remember to read the release notes mentioned above. They contain helpful and up-to-date information about running this version of the Navigator.
