## **## Welcome to Win32 Assembly Programming**

This Win32 prototype program is an example of what can be done programming to the Win32 API using assembly language.

The whole program could have been implemented in a single source file, saving many lines of repetitive code (mainly the base framework ahead of each .ASM source file).

We instead chose to break the program into several separate modules, leaving as little code as possible in the main module, in order to demonstrate one way a large project could be handled to remain manageable.
