

FTP HUMAN RESOURCES DATABASE MANAGER

This program was created originally to help us keep track of our small staff here at FTP. As it's a good example of what can be done using VB and Access together, we thought we'd make it available to our subscribers as well. You could even use it as an HR system for your company (if you don't mind the fact that our personnel policies are hard-coded into it)!

Part of the challenge was to make something so easy to understand and use that a Help file wouldn't be necessary. At the same time we tried to include most of the basic functionality an HR system would need. (Naturally, many more features could have been added, but we wanted to keep it simple.) Please bear in mind that the app was designed to run on systems here at FTP and hasn't been exhaustively tested for compatibility with other machine configurations. It probably will run fine in most minimum Windows 3.1 VGA environments, but there's always a chance of encountering quirks in some memory setups, displays drivers or other components.

Also, it's new (release 1.0). We always hope we've found all the bugs, but we probably haven't. If you come across something, please let us know.
