Operating Instructions.

This software is really self explanatory, however im including a brief doc file for those of your who want to know what everything does.

NOTE: Visual Basic must not be running when launching or compiling an application. If it is, you will be prompted to close it.

Configure Button

This takes you to the configuration screen (explained later)

VB Load

This loads the selected .MAK files into visual basic.

Compile

This will compile, and optionally load (See configuration) the selected .MAK file.

Add

This will **permantly** add a .MAK file to the listbox. Removing it requires editing the VBPP.INI file located in your windows directory.

Min

This will minimize the program

Exit

Configuration Menu

Here you can select up to 4 **alternative** VB.EXE files. If for some reason you have VB2 VB3 and VB4 on your system, you can select which one you want this program to compile with. Only 1 can be selected at a time. The **default** option can **not** be changed, this is read from your VB.INI file. You may however select an alternate option.

Minimize On Load

This option will minimize the program when you use the VB LOAD button.

Load After Compile

This will load the program after you compile it. This is useful if you are working out bugs in the compiled version. If you select this option, after the compile finishes, it will reload your application. This is a **very** handy feature that other .MAK compilers do not support.

Load VB.INI files.

This will load the last for files used by VB from VB.INI. This same list appears under FILE in visual basic.
