Botticelli is creativity game that MarvL sponsors every Tuesday night at 6pm. The rules are quite simple. A general category is posted for the evening. Last Tuesday the category was Love and Marriage.

Whoever wins a round gets from 10T-40T depending on the length of the round, and provides the secret word for the next round. Whoever is IT ghosts at the end of that round to make room for another player. Ghosts are encouraged to ESP suggestions to the players. This has two benefits:

- It helps a lot when somebody is struggling with English as a second language, or just plain struggling.
- It gives everybody a chance to realize what it feels like when you are getting blasted by ESPs.

The first hint is always the beginning letter of the word, and MarvL started off with, Category is Love and Marriage: Word begins with W !!

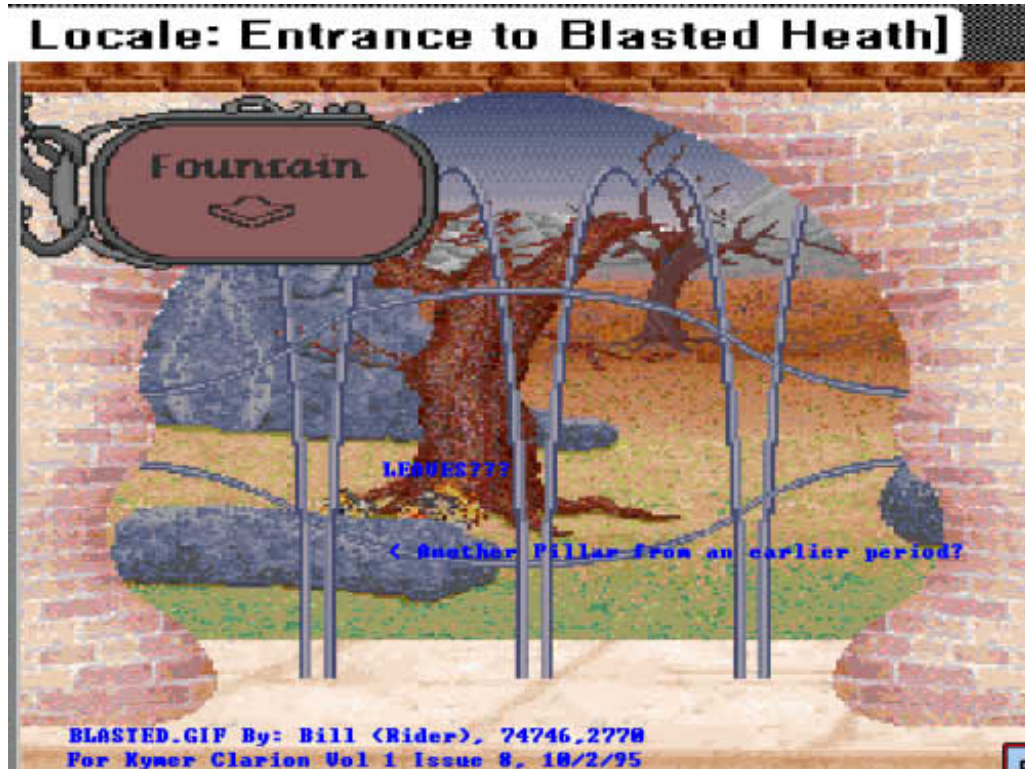

Guilds: A Proposal And A Meeting

Hi, my name is Fawn, and I want to tell you about an experience I had in Phantasus recently. My older sister and mentor, Acolyte Indigo was a beta tester. Through her experience, I have enjoyed watching the growth of the WA community since its beginning.

I sometimes have trouble with the simple logistics of getting around and buying selling giving putting items where I would like. Thanks especially to Holger, who offered his time and sense of humor to help me find my way, now I have a strong sense of the city layout and I can get around the city. I have had the support of Rydia (Zippy) and my step-brother Ravenwhyte in creating and hosting a Pitfall-Sunrise game. Finally I come to the on-line event that inspired in me an idea and a proposal for increasing the creative responsibilities of the avatar population.

I was in the Temple with a fellow avatar named Passion, whom I had just met. A generous male avatar offered us both one of his carrying chests. We followed him to the Temple where we searched for a room in which he could safely put the chests down. Perhaps he was assuming that in an open situation these items would be instantly stolen! I must admit, I silently wondered why this had to be so secretive... who would steal something that obviously belonged to someone else? This generous avatar both refused money and told us not to tell anyone where we got the trunks.

We can cast an aura of doubt and suspicion over anything.. or we can do the opposite. and believe that -given the choice- people choose right over wrong... This might be a "Pollyanna attitude-but I have seen that goodness and selfless motivation are contagious if they are used repeatedly. Why?

I believe these positive human attributes carry power of their own. The power to unite people in a common effort, the power to give hope ... Let's face it, I can give my fellow avatar the benefit of the doubt. With that I entrust him with the responsibility of making the morally correct choice.

Going back to the story, I was suddenly recalled to the Waking World. When after a long time I returned to the Earth Room, there was no sign of a chest... so I gave it up as gone. That night I was passing through a Star Trek game where Acolyte Data was hosting. He quickly ESP'd me to tell me that he had my carrying chest in safe keeping!!!

Here, indeed, honesty and moral judgment triumphed!! Passion had reported the lost trunk to the Acolyte on duty- who happened to be my brother-in-law, Acolyte Data. He, in turn, did the appropriate thing to secure its safety. And he would have done this for anyone!

There is a lot of significance to this 'lost and found' chest. I did not know Passion prior to that night so -after I crashed-, she could have taken the chest for herself or sold it to another and we might never have had an occasion to talk again.. Instead, she chose to protect my belongings. She set in motion a chain of events which involved an Acolyte and his role in safeguarding someone's lost property.

By choosing to safeguard the chest, these people were creating a safe environment for me to return to. Believe me - from my unsafe experiences in the Outworld- a safe environment would be my DREAM come true, if it were a reality in the Dreamscape. Avatars don't have a coherent group identity like the small group of Acolytes ... and yet we have the opportunity to create that identity for ourselves!! First we need to decide what we want to take from the community and what we want to give to it. In either case, -we need to realize that our actions have an impact on others.

We are all individuals with ambitions, drives, talents, and the need to share. I think we can create an outlet for these skills that would generate a strong and very positive group identity. We could create Guilds to give us a place to share and develop our skills and an Association of Guilds that brought us together with a common purpose.

For instance, I am an artist and I feel I could benefit from an artist guild. I am using the word 'artist' in the broadest sense of the word- all the skills involved in theatre, music, dance & creativity!!

The Arts have always played a major part in the moral and spiritual standards of a culture. So why not organize a way for people to work together to beautify public and private places. Why not enable artists to have exhibits of their work and take commissions for decorating public and/or private turfs? Guilds have always provided a moral and spiritual foundation for their members. They can also provide a positive collective identity for avatars.

Do any of these ideas relate to my lost and found chest story?

My trunk escaped the fate of being stolen simply because of the values that two individuals had. A Safe Environment Guild could offer us a Lost and Found service that protects our items. People could bring a lost or abandoned item to this drop-off place and they could retrieve their lost or stolen items at the same site. We can extend this to our pet animals that are lost or found, injured or abandoned. The guild provides the opportunity to have concerned people clean up the environment safely.

It also gives everyone the option of helping each other. There can even be a prize or reward offered to the person who has found and returned it. Eventually, good deeds become rewards in themselves. Reward incentive is a valid way to inspire it!

First Meeting; First week in November Preliminary ideas for the Structure of a Guild Association: We are all with One Purpose: Service to the Community

1. Each avatar should write about his strongest skill and what guild would help him share his skills
2. Individual Guild responsibilities to the community will be established by the Guild Association
3. All Guilds will have annual dues for membership and elections for officers
4. All Guilds will have several services: such as Newsletters that explain technical and psychological aspects of their trades
