SessionLog has been written for use in recording studios by a studio owner / engineer. I have worked long and hard to make it intuitive and useful without getting in the way. Hope it works for you as well as it does for me.

SessionLog is shareware, the fee is £20.00. You can register at:

Registration is secure and fast. The code you will receive will remove the reminder. SessionLog is limited to 10 launches which should be enough evaluation time. It is fully functional throughout the trial period. After that, the "Not Yet" button will be disabled.

Included files:

prefs.slg.... Some default prefs to get you started.

NB: reg.slg. will be created when you register.

"pb.dat" and "pbbak.dat" will be created when you enter data into PlayerBase.

"diary.dat" will be created when you make an entry into the session diary.

Always keep the above files together in the same folder/directory.

Sessions... An empty folder. Why not store your session files here.

Windows Users.

SessionLog has been written on Mac computers and compiled for Windows. I've tested it with Virtual PC running Windows 98. Not the best way I know, but buying a Windows PC just to test shareware is beyond budget. DO thoroughly test it before you register. I will always try to solve any problems encountered as quickly as possible.

Overview:

SessionLog is software for recording/project/Midi studios, mastering suites etc.

- It keeps track of session times, song titles, lengths and lyrics.
- It keeps track of people too. Up to 23 per song.
- It incorporates PlayerBase, an address book that's always to hand.
- FX and Midi settings can be stored per song along with cue points, comments, and all track listings.
- It also keeps track of stock used and can issue warnings when stock levels are low.
- SessionLog automatically calculates the cost of hours and stock used, and can print invoices.

- SessionLog prints track sheets customised to your requirements with your studio name, logo, address etc. Or multiple song blanks.
- SessionLog has a diary to keep track of studio bookings, a simple calculator and a guitar/bass/6 octave chromatic tuner built in.

If you are upgrading, be careful not to overwrite your existing files.
