**Maguma AG releases Maguma PHP4EE Studio Light at International PHP Conference**

Maguma AG, the company that I'm running, is to present a [light-version of the source-code editor Maguma PHP4EE Studio](#) at the upcoming PHP conference in Frankfurt. It will be made available on November 6th for [public download](#). This editor features code-completion and function-insight, command sensitive PHP-help as well as syntax highlighting. Maguma PHP4EE Studio has an interface to the runtime-environment of the Maguma PHP4EE server, project-management functions, and a version control system for the source code as well as an integrated debugger and profiler for PHP-applications. The light-version of PHP4EE Studio has the same feature-set as the full version, apart from Maguma-PHP4EE-specific features, as for example the interfaces to the Maguma PHP4EE Server and to the version-control system.

With Maguma PHP4EE Studio Light Maguma makes a powerful editor, which is constantly worked on, available for the community for free. In addition to this, several collaborators of Maguma have been active in the PHP scene as authors of articles, open-source software, and PHP quality assurance for a long time.
