Introduction

PSCorel is a PostScript Font Downloader designed to work with CorelDraw version 4.00 and PSCRIPT.DRV - the Windows PostScript printer driver. PSCorel works by monitoring CorelDraw's output to PSCRIPT.DRV. When it senses a printer job being sent to PSCRIPT.DRV from CorelDraw!, it pops up a dialog box prompting you to select PostScript fonts to be downloaded with your document. Simply make your selections and click on OK. The fonts will be downloaded to the printer with your document. CorelDraw! will then proceed to finish printing. You will not notice a difference in functionality whether you print to a port or to File. As with all document embedded downloadable soft fonts, printer memory is cleared at the end of the print job.

Installation and Requirements

PSCorel should be installed on your hard disk. PSCOREL2.EXE and PSCD2.DLL need to reside in the same subdirectory. PSCorel requires Windows 3.1, PSCRIPT.DRV v3.52 or later, and Adobe Type Manager for Windows (ATM).

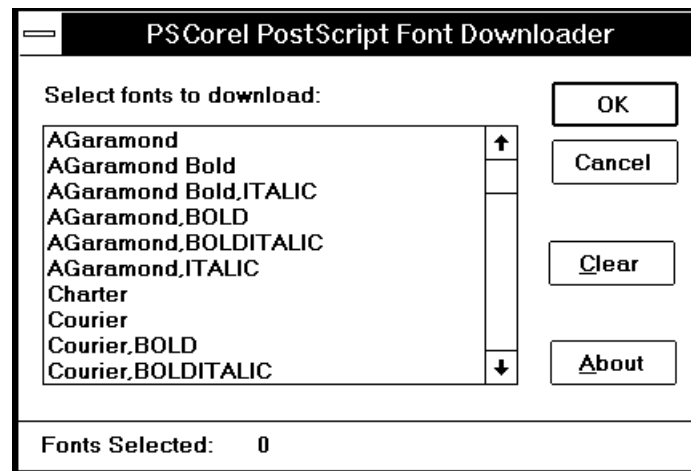

Using PSCorel

When you first run PSCorel it becomes an icon on your desktop. PSCorel will remain an icon until you print from CorelDraw to your PostScript printer. You can launch PSCorel either before or after you've launched CorelDraw. No functionality is available when PSCorel is in the iconic state except access to the About box from PSCorel's system menu and the ability to close the program.

PSCorel is self-activated after you make your final selections in CorelDraw's Printer dialog box and click on **OK**. If PSCorel senses output being sent to a PostScript printer from CorelDraw it pops up a dialog box that looks like this:



The listbox on PSCorel's dialog box contains your PostScript Type 1 fonts as they are installed in ATM.INI. Highlight the fonts you want to download with your CorelDraw document and click on **OK** (up to 10 fonts may be selected). PSCorel will proceed to download your soft fonts and CorelDraw will finish printing. For easy reference PSCorel keeps a count of selected fonts on the dialog box's status line.

PSCorel remembers your selections after each printing session so you don't have to re-select your soft fonts each time.

To quickly clear all selections click on the **Clear** button.

If you don't want to download any fonts with your document, click on **Cancel**. This won't Cancel the print job - just the font downloading.

To end PSCorel, click on the PSCorel icon and select **Close** from the system menu.

Note: For CorelDraw to be able to use your downloaded soft fonts, the fonts need to be marked as resident in CORELDRW.INI, i.e. the entries in the PSResidentFonts section must be followed by either a 1 or a 3. As an alternative, if you are downloading all fonts referenced in your document, select All Fonts Resident in CorelDraw's Printer Setup.
