## List the games by Overall Score



Un-install a program


## Un-install a program

## **1. Games Display Screen**

Displays the look of the game.

## **2. Evaluation**

Displays the rating system from 1 - 9, on the Quality of the graphics, sound, animation and overall performances of the particular game selected.

## **3. Game Summary**

Displays an overall summary of the games category, amount of hard drive space it requires, registrations fees and other information on the location of the particular game selected.

## **4. Category of Games Scroll Menu**

Judging by the way of sorting the games into a particular category, this displays the order of game. To choose a particular game, use the scroll up and down buttons to view the list of games in the category.

## **5. View Manual**

When you click onto this button it brings up the Manual for that particular game selected.

## **6. Run From CD**

Allows you to run the game highlighted in the scroll menu straight from CD without installing onto your hard drive.

## **7. Install To Hard drive**

Installs the selected game onto your hard drive directly from this screen.

## **8. Selection Menu**

Returns you to the Selection Menu.

## **9. Exit**

Exits the program.
