

Exterior Painting Tips:

Before you start painting, take a good, hard look at the surface condition of your home. Problems like peeling, mildew, and rust need to be corrected before you begin painting.

Prevent cracking and peeling by following these tips:

1. Remove underlying coats of non-adhering paint.
2. Choose a primer and topcoat that will work together.
3. Allow adequate drying time between coats.

To expedite surface preparation, consider using power-washing equipment. Fast and effective, power washers use a pressurized spray to rid walls of dirt, chalk, mildew - even loose, peeling or flaking paint.

Start with a Glidden primer. Priming provides both short- and long-term benefits that make taking that extra step worthwhile. Use primer to cover stains, improve topcoat coverage, create a strong sealer and enhance hide. Synthetic angled trim brushes (1-1/2" and 2"-inch brushes will serve most needs)

Synthetic broadwall brush (4" to 5" inches wide)
