

Talking Solitaire

Talking Solitaire is just like Windows Solitaire with a few nifty differences:

- o You can hear the cards in a stack, using a configurable voice and face
- o You can flip over and rearrange cards in the stacks (i.e. you can cheat!)

To choose a new voice or face:

- o Choose Voice setup... or Face setup... from the control menu of Talking Solitaire. The control menu is the small square in the upper-left corner of the window.

To hear the cards as they're dealt:

- o Click on the deck with the *right* mouse button instead of the left one.

To hear what all cards in a stack are (including the upside-down ones!):

- o Click on the stack using the *right* mouse button.

To flip over all upside-down cards in a stack:

- o Hold down the *alt* key on your keyboard .
- o Click on the stack using the *right* mouse button.

To "rotate" the cards in a stack from bottom to top:

- o Hold down the *shift* key on your keyboard .
- o Click on the stack using the *right* mouse button.

To "rotate" the cards in a stack from top to bottom:

- o Hold down the *control* key on your keyboard .
- o Click on the stack using the *right* mouse button.
