Using PrintObj

To use PrintObj add the unit to your *uses* clause. Then simply Initialize the PrintSet variable (one has been declared for you), set the desired printer property(ies) and then Destroy. Ex:

  PrintSet := TPrintSet.Create;
  PrintSet.PaperSize := dmPaper_Legal;
  PrintSet.Copies := 5;
  PrintSet.Free;

    {changes will be reflected in PrintDialog and PrinterSetupDialog}
end; { TForm1.Print1Click }
```
