Color Creator Help

The color creator can be used to send colorized text to the window currently active in mIRC. The active window is the one with color in the title bar; the rest are grayed out.

Text color is set by selecting a forecolor and a backcolor. The forecolor refers the the color of the text itself; the backcolor refers to the color of the background behind the text.

You can click once on any of the colors in the forecolor and backcolor rows. The arrow beneath the row indicated which color is currently selected. To use the colors currently shown, double click in either row. Be sure to double-click in one of the boxes you want to use or you will change the currently set color before it sets that code.

Once a color is selected, the color codes will appear in the text box. Leave them there! You may enter text at any time into the text box and change colors as often as you like in the same line. Also, you can click **Bold**, **Underlined**, or **Reverse** at any time. To shut off the bold, underline, or reverse at any time during a line, click it again.

To send the text currently in the edit box, click **Send & Clear** to send the text and clear the edit box, or **Send, Don't Clear** if you want to send it again (or want to edit the same text).

If this program is running minimized or is not visible, it can be activated from Little Star by typing /color.
