
Directory Listing

This appendix lists the ImageStor program files. Use this list as a reference whenever you need to know where a file is stored a result of installing ImageStor.

We recommend creating a directory called \IMAGSTOR in which to copy the program files. When you unzip the ImageStor product, the follow files are copied to the installation directory.

IMAGSTOR.EXE	The ImageStor program file. Executes the program and holds the information displayed on the ImageStor screens.
P_IMSTOR.DAT	Data file used by the program. Must reside in the same directory as IMAGSTOR.EXE.
P_IMSTOR.CPY	A backup copy of P_IMSTOR.DAT. Used when creating a bootable diskette.
ISPREFS.DAT	Used to record and restore ImageStor preferences.
ISENG.EXE	The ImageStor engine. Supports data transfers between two devices, handles differences between the source and target device, and supports raw image transfers when more than one partition exists on the source device.
ISBOOT.EXE	Program file which creates a bootable diskette directly.
DRIVERS.LST	Text file used to create a bootable diskette.
README.TXT	Text file that identifies last minute changes to the product.
