

Using the Paste Panel

Hint: Save the image, move the paste, save again. Easy animation.

Autofit - Click until the check box appears to stretch the image to the window size.

Undo / Redo - Use undo to correct mistakes. Use undo/redo to test animation. Flip back and forth to test movement.

Zoom - You can touch up areas while zoomed in but it is recommended that you use "resize image" instead.

Pasting

Size - 1/2 to reduce the paste by half, x2 to double the size. You can save the frame (drag from main) go back, double the size and repeat to create a zoom effect.

Size arrows - Up enlarges the paste, Down shrinks it.

OK - Not necessary, but you can finalize the paste with this button.

Drag - When checked, the paste leaves a trail as it is moved. Unchecked leaves no trail.

Normal - If you have been adjusting the size of the paste, it will revert back to the original size if it can.

W - Adjust the width of the paste.

H - Adjust the height of the paste.

U/D - Move the paste up or down 10 pixels.

L/R - Move the paste left or right 10 pixels.

Green arrows - Move the paste left, right, up or down 1 pixel.

Rotate - Will rotate the paste the number of degrees in the box.

Green Left/Right arrows - Mirror the paste.

Dark Imprint - Places a shadow imprint on the page the shape of the paste. Use a transparent type image for best result such as a black and white clipart.

Light Imprint - Same as above only instead of darker it makes

the area lighter.
