HOW TO NAVIGATE WINONLINE™ PUBLICATIONS

The Windows Help system is used by our magazines. It's a convenient way to view Hypertext files like the WinOnLine magazine you are reading now. Here are a few tips to make your reading more pleasurable and convenient:

The Help Button Bar at the top is arranged to help you move easily through the magazine:



The **Contents** button, when clicked, will return you to our Table of Contents

Search starts a dialog box with all the keywords that can refer to different sections and articles in the magazine. Try it and see.

History displays a listing of the places in the magazine you have been so you can return

Print Topic will send the article you are currently reading to the printer. It will not print "popup" boxes, though.

<<Page | Page>> can perhaps be the best way to view WinOnLine Publications. With these buttons you can browse through the magazine in page order, just as you would a paper magazine.

You may use the keyboard Page Up, Page Down and Up and Down Arrow keys to forward and backward in an article, or use mouse clicks on the vertical bar shown on the right.

The automatic **Pop-Ups** throughout the issue can be cleared from view by a simple mouse click anywhere on the screen. You will find that some may have a special bit of text that, when clicked, will take you even further to another page, function or popup. Using the **Back** button will always return you to where you have been.

Certain bits of text may be a different color or underlined, usually indicating that clicking on them will cause something to happen. Certain graphics, such as the authors' at the close of each article, are keyed to a popup image such as information about the author. When you see your arrow cursor change to a hand, you are on such a spot. [Click on this text](#) (see the special color and how your cursor changes?) to see what happens.

CACHE LA BYTE COMMENTARY

It was a dark and quiet night when the phone rang at 11:15 p.m. on August 23. I was expecting the voice at the other end, the gravelly tones of Dr. Ed Hoffman (sometimes known as “The Shareware Sleuth”). We had a mission to undertake, and he was reminding me to awaken from my evening nap. We planned to be among the participants at Midnight Madness. I assured him I was awake.

Moments later, my aging Dodge Caravan surged out of the driveway, destined for Dr. Ed's driveway, where he stood in the dark, waiting. Ed assumed the passenger's seat, and closed the door quietly. No purpose in arousing his non-Madness neighbors.

Disguised as ordinary shoppers, we arrived in the parking lot of the local Egghead Software store at 11:38 p.m. I jotted a note of the time on a parking ticket remnant, because I wanted to assure my recollection of the events would have accuracy. There were approximately 70 persons milling around, loosely organized in a queue at Egghead's door. Our parking lot location gave us a good vantage point, so we decided to observe (for now) rather than participate.

Nine months into the Year 1995, we were awaiting the over-the-counter release of Microsoft Windows 95.

At 11:48, two people emerged from the adjacent Dairy Queen, jostled their way through the small crowd, and looked back in wonderment. My well-honed reporter instincts, always ready for the potential of unruliness in crowds, told me to remove the lens cap from my inconspicuous Samurai camera. But the crowd remained quiescent, almost placid, with most motions involving raising a wristwatch-wearing arm to check the time. I was struck with a childhood reminiscence of watching cattle awaiting milking. Ed said it was like kids awaiting the arrival of a department-store Santa.

And he continued, “I didn't expect this many.” I replied, “I think we better get in line.” Ed said, “I don't want to walk all the way down there just to walk back.” We compromised by dismounting, and standing in observer positions near the front door. I was eavesdropping on the various conversations, one of which included a description of that person's wait-in-line for tickets to a Rolling Stones concert. The other person was countering with a description of waiting in line for Colorado Rockies tickets.

Two other persons were speculating between themselves about what differences the OTC version of the much-heralded product would have between it and the widely-circulated beta version “Build 490.” In fact, their conversation was louder than necessary -- the talkers wanted others to know they were official Microsoft “beta testers.” I recalled the guinea pigs I had raised as a 4-H project during my Indiana farm-boy youth.

At midnight, a smiling Egghead employee (you'd smile, too, with a crowd of customers at your door) opened the door and the shoppers began filing in. My Samurai's built-in flash stayed

busy, as I recorded the scene (and I was envious of the TV crew that was videotaping without the need for lights). The brightly-lighted store had undergone a virtual interior facelift, since it's 9 p.m. closing when employees began revealing their stock of Win95 products. Within seconds, the first handful of customers were at the checkout-cash register counters, checkbooks or credit cards at the ready.

Ed and I browsed. We weren't in a hurry. A shorts-clad female high schooler appeared to be the youngest present, and she had obviously come for more than the new Windows product -- she had three software boxes under one arm, and continued browsing. (Computer-male chauvinists take note: This particular crowd was comprised of at least 15% females.)

By 12:15 a.m., the store was packed, people nearly shoulder-to-shoulder, with my reporter-trained eye estimating the crowd at 120. A well-stocked coffee-and-snacks table was at the rear of the store, but few people were partaking. Several operating PCs displayed various Win95 images on their screen.

My Ziff-Davis Interactive reviewer's job had already equipped me with a CD-ROM version of Win95, but I wanted what the "real world" has, so I grabbed a release floppy-disk version and the CD-ROM version of the Plus! pack. After all, my free-lance reviewer's job says these are legitimate business expenses. I also picked up another 540 MB hard drive, given my then-single Win95 testing machine was already overflowing its original 213 MB drive.

Ed liked the special 10% discount of products purchased during Midnight Madness, so he also picked up a 540 MB drive. Quite luckily, as events were to reveal. A few days later, an already-installed same-size drive was to become the subject of a factory-authorized RMA when it quit under stress.

Ed and I adjourned to an all-night eatery, me carrying my Win95 purchases for closer examination while we had an early breakfast. It was my intent to begin my installation shortly, holding to my hacker image of working late into the night as Coke cans litter the floor. Ed was also going back to work; writers work unbelievable hours.

It was 1:38 a.m., August 24. Coast-to-coast, Midnight Madness had come and gone.

Despite the Mac-ites snarl of “Win95=Mac87,” we knew we had participated in a significant national event, one likely to be ignored by historians -- but what do they know?

The waitress, eyeing the boxes I had in front of me, said: “Oh, you went to Midnight Madness.” The event had been well-publicized, via print, TV and radio -- even civilians were casualties of this war.

Ed said, “Yep...sure did.”

The waitress said, “I can't stand computers.”

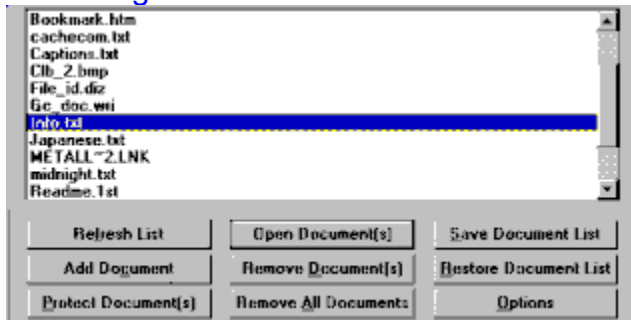

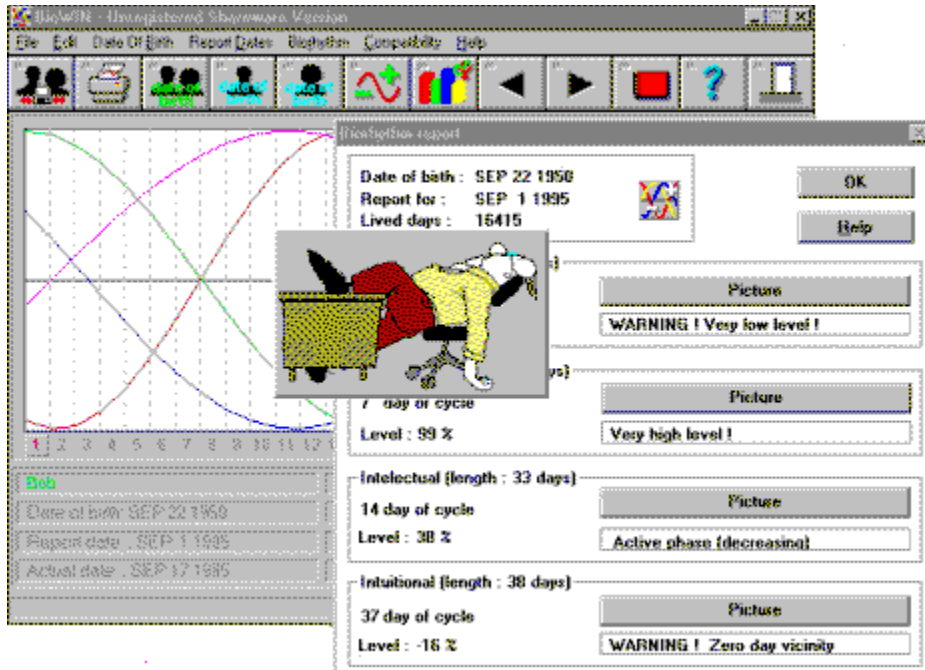
Stemming the overflow Document List

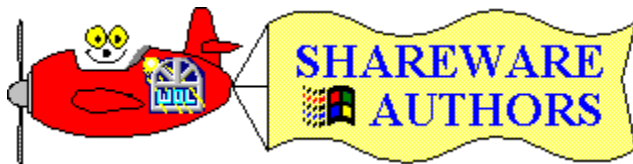
BIOWIN

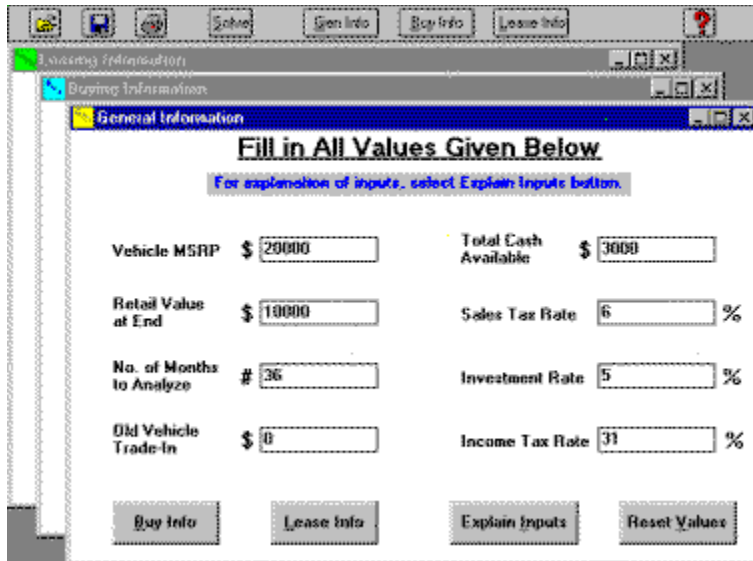

WINDOWS RESTART 95

Yeah, we all knew it was coming...



The parade begins. Wolly waited in dread for the flood of Windows 95 shareware from the Department of Redundancy Department. In all fairness, **this is a nice example of a the "Restart" genre, complete with several options** for your own needs. You can **add a taskbar icon** to activate the menu shown, or **go directly to a shut down, reboot, or to log off a network**, and you can also **choose a hot key** from predefined combinations for the same choices. Wolly tested WR95V401.ZIP, but **WR95V409.ZIP (111K)** arrived as we went to press, and can be registered for **\$10.00**. And worry not, while this is a nice one that you should consider, you can wait if you like; there'll be more. What really scares Wolly is the infinite

number of resource monitors that are waiting in the wings.

BARRY PRESS UTILITIES

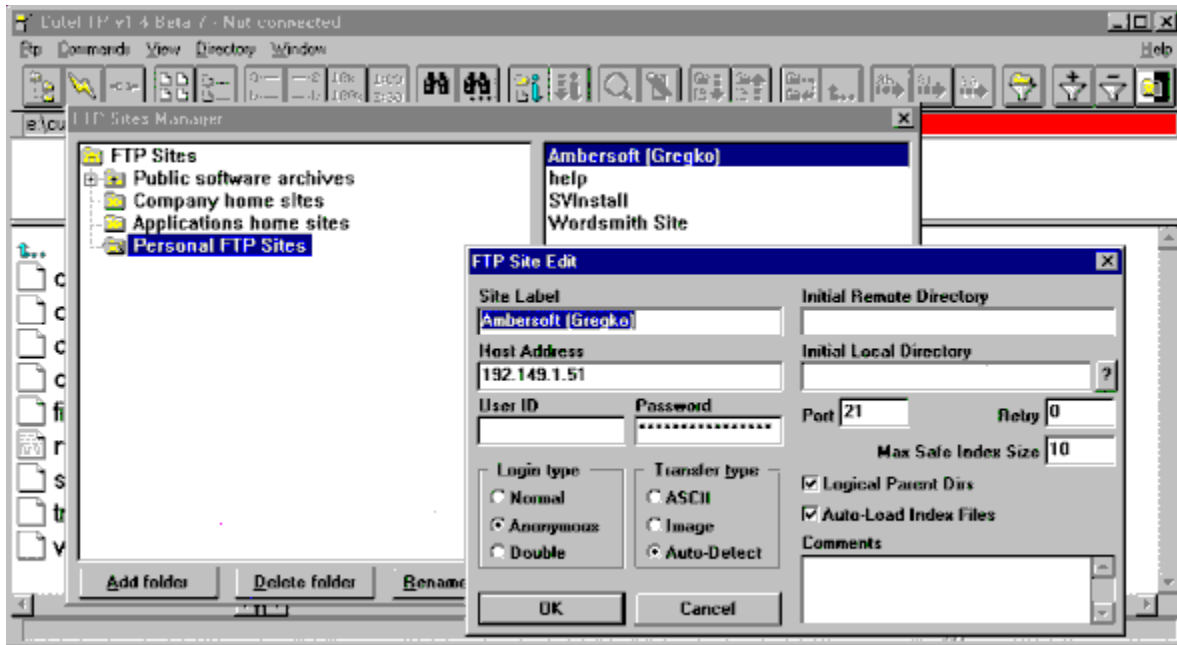
Applets of your eye



Ed Hoffman told Wolly about a **handy collection of Windows 95 applets** available in the Barry Press Utilities for Windows 95; in fact, he told us all of the following, and threatened us with bodily harm if we changed a word. He says that the collection includes a simple **monthly calendar**, a **drag-and-drop ASCII file printer**, an **ASCII file comparison program**, a shell extension to add a **command line option to the Explorer** (like the old File-Run), a **digital clock**, and a **random multimedia file player**. However, despite the utility of these other programs, the *Flipper* applet is the one utility in this collection that has proved to be the **most useful**. Though this applet only serves one function, **switching your printer orientation between portrait and landscape**, it performs this operation very nicely. Rather than fumbling through a host of menus and dialog boxes, *Flipper* allows you to control the printer orientation by simply clicking a small icon the program inserts right beside the **time** on your taskbar. Clicking the icon changes both the printer orientation and the icon itself. With portrait orientation, the icon shows a vertical Dolphin (a.k.a. Flipper) and the Dolphin is shown horizontal when the printer orientation is set to landscape. So, not only will the icon change between the two printer orientations, but it even shows you the present printer orientation. The *Flipper* utility alone is actually worth the \$20.00 registration fee for the complete collection, available as BPUT32.ZIP (622K).

CUTEFTP

Yeah, I know



Wolly just told you about this cutie a couple issues ago (WOLR 100), but not only did **get better**, it's become **FREWARE!** Now that I have your attention, download **CFTP14B7.ZIP** (225K) to enjoy its **ease of use and improvements**. Create your own **library of sites to visit at a click, and drag and drop files** once you get there. Hey, has Wolly ever lied to you before? Just download it, check it out, and then thank the author, Alex Kunadze, whom you'll find in South Korea seeking a job. You'll also find his resume included. Cute. <g>

THUMBNAILER

Thumb your way on Netscape

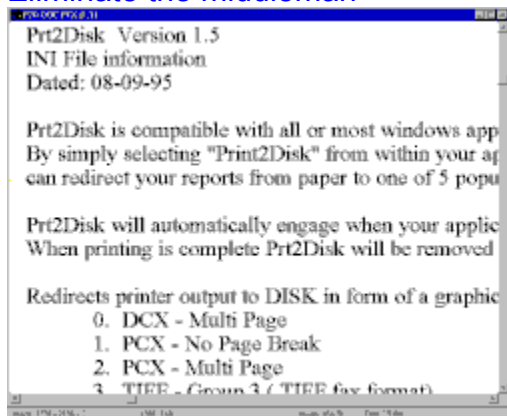


This is a kind of neat utility that could appeal especially to the web constructors in the

audience. It **creates HTML files and uses Netscape to view thumbnails of GIF files.** Move to the directory you want to index, and it **quickly creates INDEX.HTM and THUMB.HTM files.** Open Netscape and the index, through the program itself if you want, and **click on the catalog to view. Thumbnails appear,** in the size and in the number of columns you have chosen; **click on any to view the GIF. Very slick.** There are a bunch of **other options** in this cleverly done piece of work. **THMBNAIL.ZIP** (139K) is **freeware** for **non-commercial** uses; otherwise, contact the author.

PRINT2DISK

Eliminate the middleman



Take the **output from virtually any Windows program** and direct it to this **special printer driver — go direct to file as an image!** Print2Disk delivers the output in the form of a **PCX** with or without page breaks, a multipage **DCX**, or a GammaFax or Group 3 **TIFF** file. It's real simple, with a **popup dialog for you to specify your output format**, which can be in **fine or standard resolutions.** **P2DSK15A.ZIP** (351K) is registerable for the amount of **\$15.00.**



QUARRY

Rock on



It's a simple game; you'd think that Wolly would get the hang of it quickly. You overestimate Wolly, the inveterate non-gamer. Doesn't mean that *you* wouldn't **have fun trying to get your miners to the other side before your computer opponent**, or get a kick out of them **drilling, staring at each other, and sitting down on the job**. **QUARRY12.ZIP** (1074K) has nice artwork and is a cute game of the vintage variety, where **no one gets shot, your heart doesn't race, and strategy, not speed, counts**. Register Quarry from Soleau Software for **\$18.00**, and get discounts on their other games.

FILENAME GAMES

Zip Zip, Bo-Bip, Banana-nana-bo-bip...

Just as quickly as Wolly reviews programs, replacements arrive, and filenames published become obsolete. The Windows OnLine™ staff polices the file areas, cleaning out the old to make room for the new. Wolly's oft-repeated point is that you should consider looking for the program name, not the file. Filenames are often changed or distorted by some on-line services, and as mentioned above, may be updated by the time you read this.

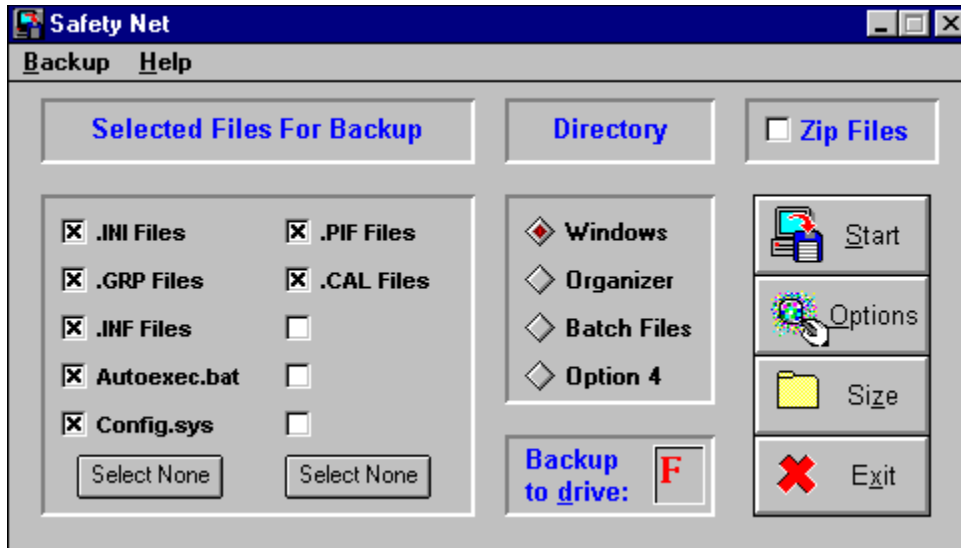
SAFETYNET

a review by Ed Hoffman

One of the more irritating facts of living with computers is the raft of surprises that often befall the unsuspecting user. Whether from our own hand or by way of an obnoxious program that installs itself and rewrites many of our important files, most computer users quickly realize the importance of the AUTOEXEC.BAT, CONFIG.SYS, SYSTEM.INI and the WIN.INI files on our systems. Though most software programs are reasonably well behaved and offer the user an opportunity to say, "Yes" or "No" to many installation options, others just add entries to these important system files without asking. Aside from increasing the size of the system files, these entries do not usually affect the operation of the computer. Occasionally, however, after these programs are installed, you may find that your system no longer operates as before. What can you do? Your option is to either live with the changes or try to pour over these files to determine what changes were made, and how best to effect a fix.

Another situation that often occurs is when we manually make changes to any of these files. Tinkering with the AUTOEXEC.BAT, CONFIG.SYS, SYSTEM.INI and WIN.INI files, though sometimes necessary, can be disastrous unless you know exactly what you are doing. One way to save yourself considerable grief is to make a copy of these files before making any changes. However, more often than not, it isn't until after these changes are made and a problem pops up that we begin to think that we should have made a copy. But, as you might suspect, it is a bit late by this time.

Surprising as it may seem, right now, while your system is operating properly, is the best time to save yourself trouble. There is only one foolproof way to protect yourself — keep an up-to-date backup copy of these files. As most of us learn, sooner or later, when working with computers in general and Windows in particular, the three most important words to remember are BACKUP, BACKUP, and BACKUP. If you have yet to experience any problem with these files, you are very, very fortunate. I would suggest, however, that you are living on borrowed time. I learned my lesson after a few frustrating episodes where I had to re-edit my WIN.INI, SYSTEM.INI, CONFIG.SYS AUTOEXEC.BAT and a few other files. Then I began keeping separate copies of these files safely hidden on a floppy. You may also wish to use this approach. Thankfully, there is a simpler and easier way to save yourself the trouble of manually copying these files. The answer is a unique shareware program called [SafetyNet 3.3](#).



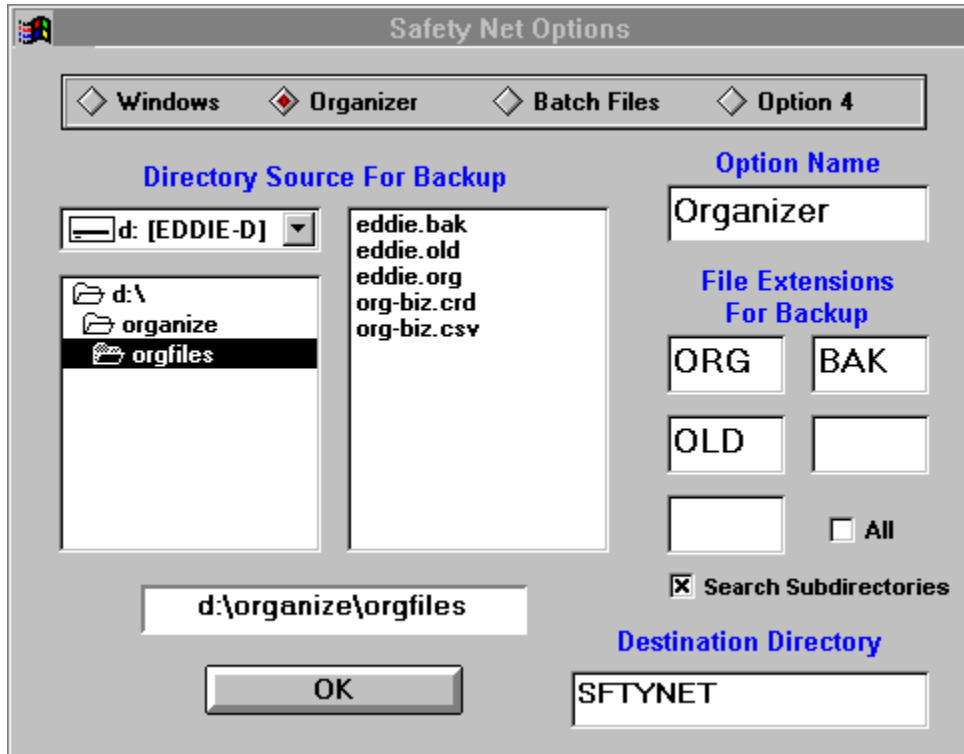
The **SafetyNet** program not only makes copies of the AUTOEXEC.BAT, CONFIG.SYS, WIN.INI, and SYSTEM.INI files, it can also be configured to save just about every other important file on your system. The opening window of the program offers several categories of files to backup. Included are all INI, GRP, and PIF files, as well as the AUTOEXEC.BAT and CONFIG.SYS files. Any other special file extension you want to backup may also be specified. Personally, I also keep backup copies of all my CAL (Windows calendar) and GRP (Lotus Organizer) files.

A bonus feature of **SafetyNet**, for those running Windows 3.x, is the Make Boot Disk option. This item, handily found in the Backup menu, will allow you to create a boot disk for your system. For those not familiar with boot disks: If you have a system crash, or if your system fails to come up when you turn on your computer, many times the only way to access the computer is with a boot disk. In this case you simply insert the disk into your A-drive and reboot the computer. The system will then read the system files on your boot disk and allow you access to your system. So, should you really screw something up, you can usually fix it by using the boot disk to replace the offending file.

If your backup requirements are modest or if you only need to backup the basic Windows files, the program can be run right out of the box. The **SafetyNet** program will automatically find your Windows directory by itself. Here, all you'll need to do is install the program and click the Start button. However, if you need a bit more specialization or you want more control over the files that are backed up, the Options button allows you to customize the backup to suit your needs. The Options window allows you to specifically configure the Windows backup option as well as three additional options you can configure to suit your system. For my system, I've added options to copy my Organizer Files and Batch Files.

To setup the program for your system, simply select the Windows option and add any additional file extensions you want as part of your backup. The default extensions listed in the main program window will allow you to select all INI, GRP, and INF files as well as your Autoexec.bat and config.sys files. A check box beside these file extensions allows you the option of either selecting or de-selecting various extensions for specific backups. Any additional file

extensions you want included in your backups can be added in the Options window. Here you can add up to five more extensions. These added file extensions are then displayed on the right side of Selected Files For Backup window in the main program screen. Another nice feature available in the Windows option is the Create Subdirectories check box. Selecting this option will tell the program to create different subdirectories for each file extension. This will make finding a specific file a bit easier and will help better organize the backed up files.



Additional backup options can also be setup from the Options window. Here you need only select one of the three additional radio buttons. Once selected you can name the option in the window provided. Then, as before, you simply select the various file extensions you want included in your backup. The Search Subdirectories check box allows you to have the program search the complete directory structure for the files with the file extension you have selected. You can also specify the Destination Directory from within the Options window. This will permit each of your options to be placed in its own subdirectory.

Your backup may be copied to any drive on your system. The program default will send your backup to the A-drive. However, if you wish, you can select any other floppy drive or hard drive for the backup. Personally, I use my F-drive for these backups. One other nice feature of the program is the Zip Files check box option on the main program screen. This option tells the program to Zip the files before creating the backup. You'll find especially useful for those situations where disk space is limited or you need to place many files on a floppy disk. This option requires a copy of PKZIP on your system and noted in your path.

Unless you are very brave or have a phenomenal memory, the [SafetyNet 3.3](#) program is a Windows utility we can all put to good use. While the program has not cured me from making

my occasional stupid mistake, it sure has helped protect me from myself and from the more unruly Windows programs I often encounter. To top it off, **SafetyNet 3.3** is a Windows 3.x program that also operates quite nicely in Windows 95.

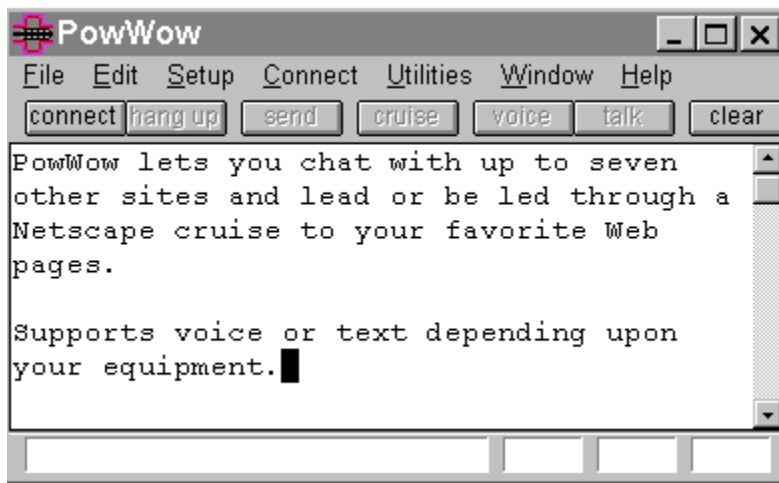
PoWWow

One of the nice features of the most popular World Wide Web browser, Netscape, is the import-export ability for bookmark lists. With the rapid growth of WWW pages, it is easy to stumble on a treasure or two that we would like to share with others. The transfer or swapping of lists of great sites is becoming commonplace. But, what if it's inconvenient to exchange disks, or you would just like to show someone a couple of particularly relevant places to support something they might be working on. Wouldn't it be nice to be able to sit over their shoulder and point out a few features of your favorite Web page to someone else? Enter *PoWWow*.

PoWWow is an add-on to Netscape. It functions primarily as a chat module to allow up to seven participants to simultaneously converse by voice or text. Often, the "chat-rooms" of the major on-line services that are usually populated with lurkers and offer little more than double-entendre loaded one-liners having little to do with the title of the chat-room. Fortunately, *PoWWow* lets you connect with whom you want and allows you the choice of entering a conversation or not.

To use *PoWWow* you need an Internet connection that supports Netscape. That usually means SLIP/PPP or direct connection. You also need Netscape. A sound card and microphone along with at least a 14.4 kbps modem will allow use of the voice features of the program. Without a sound card, you will be restricted to keyboard text entry, but you will still receive WAV sound effects if your PC speaker is enabled.



Establish a connection to your Internet service provider, then launch *PoWWow*. A simple notepad style Window is presented. From the "utilities" menu, select "White Pages". *PoWWow* will automatically launch Netscape and establish contact with *PoWWow*'s home page: <http://www.tribal.com>. You will find a link to a form that allows you to register in the White Pages. Do it, because that is the key that will allow others to contact you when you use *PoWWow* in the future. Registration includes your name (handles are OK), your Internet address, your city, state, interests, and to note if you have your own home page. If you have a home page, you can

link it to tribal.com and others can jump directly to your site. It's a good way to let a lot of folks world-wide see your page.

Once registered in the White Pages, you will be automatically logged in each time you launch *PowWow*. Three large buttons are presented to you on the tribal.com home page leading you to lists of the last 10, 25 or 50 logins to the system. Scanning the list will quickly demonstrate the power of the Web. It is routine to see users from Italy, Canada, France, Belgium, Hawaii, and, of course, throughout the USA. Simply click on a name of someone you would like to chat with, and, if they accept your chat request, your *PowWow* screen will split allowing chat windows for you and the receiver. Conversely, if you are logged in, and *PowWow* is running, anyone can click on your name on the login list and page you. You will get a dialog box identifying the caller and asking if you accept their request to chat. You can choose "yes" or "no".

Anonymous chats are fine, and *PowWow* is a great way to meet people around the world. As you are chatting, others can join the conversation by clicking on any participant in the login window. The *PowWow* screen automatically expands and divides to allow up to seven simultaneous participants. But, talking with strangers isn't everyone's cup of tea.

You can maintain a phonebook of contacts in *PowWow* and page anyone who has the software running. So, you can coordinate with friends and associates for *PowWow* session in which you chat, exchange files, and go "cruising". Cruising is the power feature of *PowWow*. On a cruise, one leader can take all the other members of a chat session through a guided tour of WWW sites. The leader's Netscape controls the presentation of Netscape to all the other participants. With typical Native American deference, the program queries whether you will accept a "cruise". If you agree, your Netscape presentation will change to reflect what the cruise leader is doing. The leader selects the sites and you see the result. If you like a site you visit, your bookmark capability is intact, so you merely click on "add bookmark" and you retain the ability to return to the site. Swapping lead on a "cruise" is simple, merely a menu click, a slight delay while the followers are given the option to come along or not, and then the new lead takes charge.

If you have a high-speed modem, a sound card and voice capability, you can operate *PowWow* in full audio mode, though that will often lose several members of a chat session because lots of folks don't have that capability. Over long distances, such as trans-oceanic, the performance is not as good as telephone, and delays can be quite noticeable, but it is definitely cheaper.

PowWow includes an array of sound effects that can be employed to punctuate the chat. Applause, boos, hello's, good-bye's and even an "are you still there?" can be inserted to punctuate the conversation. Somehow the voice reminds me of the smart-aleck caddie in Links386 who used to continually advise me that my shot was "in the deep stuff." Naturally, in the computer community, the creative are daily adding little verbal barbs to demonstrate their individuality. No telling what you might hear as add-ins to a *PowWow* session.

PowWow is the brainchild of John McAfee, the virtual godfather of anti-virus software. John is currently operating out of Woodland Park CO in an organization that, as the name of the

product and the Web page might indicate, is closely tied to Native American culture. A visit to <http://www.tribal.com> will give you not only an opportunity to enter a *PowWow* but also to explore some very interesting links with Native Americans. And, while you're running *PowWow*, you just might drop by and chat with me, thunder@rmii.com.



DRAG AND ZIP

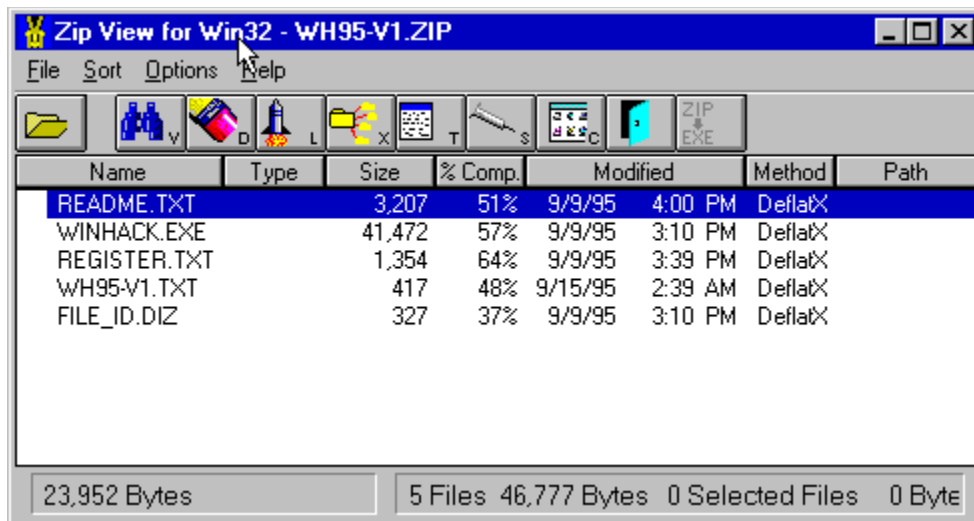

Maybe it's just an optical illusion or wishful thinking, but one thing to be said for Windows 95 is that it has already inspired some impressive shareware products. Applications and utilities that were good in the Windows 3.x versions are even better now. Canyon Software's (which is to say Dan Baumbach's) *Drag and...* series were elegantly designed and executed in their 16-bit versions. The 32-bit counterparts that have appeared so far are not only good; they are better than rival commercial products. There is not much "dragging" involved in either, anymore; these utilities have kept up with the advances of the operating system. This month I'll tell you about **Drag and Zip for Windows 95/NT**.

Drag and Zip is a file compression and decompression utility, something that any reader of the *WinOnline Review* ought to have. If you have a copy of PKZIP and are still using its DOS command line, you are wasting your time. And if you have not gotten around to registering PKZIP, you will not need to. **Drag and Zip** includes built-in PKZIP 2.04g-compatible zipping and unzipping, which includes some of PKZIP's best functionality. Even the ability to span a very large compressed file over multiple diskettes works its magic seamlessly within Windows 95. After you have installed the program, **Drag and Zip** adds the appropriate options to the right-mouse menu in Windows Explorer. It will allow you to compress the file using its built-in compression (or PKZIP or LHA if you have them on your system) or compress the file to a self-extracting executable (EXE). If the file is a compressed file with the ZIP extension, it will add *Zipview* to the menu. *ZipView* is **Drag and Zip**'s interface for decompressing files, and it offers an impressive range of functions:



It offers a peek at the contents of the zipped file, without unzipping it, and allows a formidable range of operations on these contents. If you have Canyon's **Drag and View** or the Windows 95 Quick View utility installed, you can view any registered file types for which a viewer is on offer. You can delete items from the compressed file, or add items to it, or refresh items already in it with newer versions of the same files. You can view the zip-file "comment" if there is one. And of course you can decompress the file, either the entire zipped archive or particular files within it. The dialog box that pops up when you choose to decompress lets you specify the directory in which the uncompressed files should appear. If the directory doesn't already exist, **Drag and Zip** will (after asking) create it for you. This is very useful if you're unzipping a series of files you've just downloaded and want to put each in its own temporary directory.

But it will do more than that. Canyon software has licensed Stiller Research's antivirus program Integrity Master; though not as well known as the antivirus utilities from Norton and McAfee, it is of industry-standard quality. Choose "Scan" from the Zip View menu, and Integrity Master will check the compressed file for viruses before any of them has a chance to work its evil on your system. If you make a habit of pulling files down from Internet sites, or the less well-run BBSs or on-line services, this quick procedure could (if I may adopt the vernacular to make a point forcefully) *save your butt*.

Finally, one apparently modest new feature makes **Drag and Zip** capable of supporting the other most important safety function on your computer. A button in the main dialog box is labeled "Save Set." Once you've listed all the files or directories you want to compress, you can push this button. A File|Save dialog box opens, asking you to give a filename for this new set, to which it assigns the extension DZZ. It registers this extension; so you can create a shortcut to the DZZ file, or double-click it in any file manager, and the same files or directories will be compressed again to the same location and filename. The point here is that this simple function, combined with the ability to span a zip-file across multiple diskettes, turns **Drag and Zip** into a very functional backup program, as long as your backup needs are no more elaborate than mine. You choose the directories and files you want to back up--the document and template directories from WordPerfect, say, along with the .BIF file in the Windows directory, all configuration files

for your 16-bit Windows applications, etc.--and create a "Set" to be copied to the A: drive spanning multiple diskettes. To back up all these files you don't need to launch one of those top-heavy backup programs; you just double-click on BACKUP.DZZ or whatever you have chosen to call the file. Altogether, this feature realizes beautifully a design that is nearly perfect down to its smallest details. The "Set" (DZZ) files are simple ASCII text files whose logic is as easy to master as a well-written INI file; this means that a very little programming skill would allow you to write a front-end program in Visual Basic, for example, that would allow you dynamically to change the contents of the "Set" files.

If there is any fault in this elegant utility, it is a minor one indeed: the *Zipview* option does not make itself available if you have selected a self-extracting executable in Windows Explorer. This leaves you either to use the File|Open command (much clunkier than picking a right-mouse menu item) or to devise a more efficient way of doing it. (In Windows 95 there is a more efficient way. Create a shortcut for **Zip View**, and then drag the shortcut to the "SendTo" subdirectory of your main Windows directory. Then, when you right-click on an .EXE file you know to be a self-extracting compressed file, you can choose "SendTo" and then choose "Zip View for Win 32," and the contents of the compressed file will be displayed.)

In future issues I'll describe Canyon Software's other dynamite utilities, **Drag and File** and **Drag and View**. But even if they published only **Drag and Zip**, it would be enough to earn them a special place in my heart.

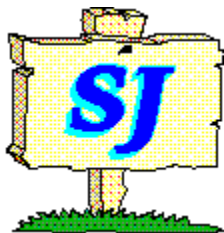

EASY ICON 95

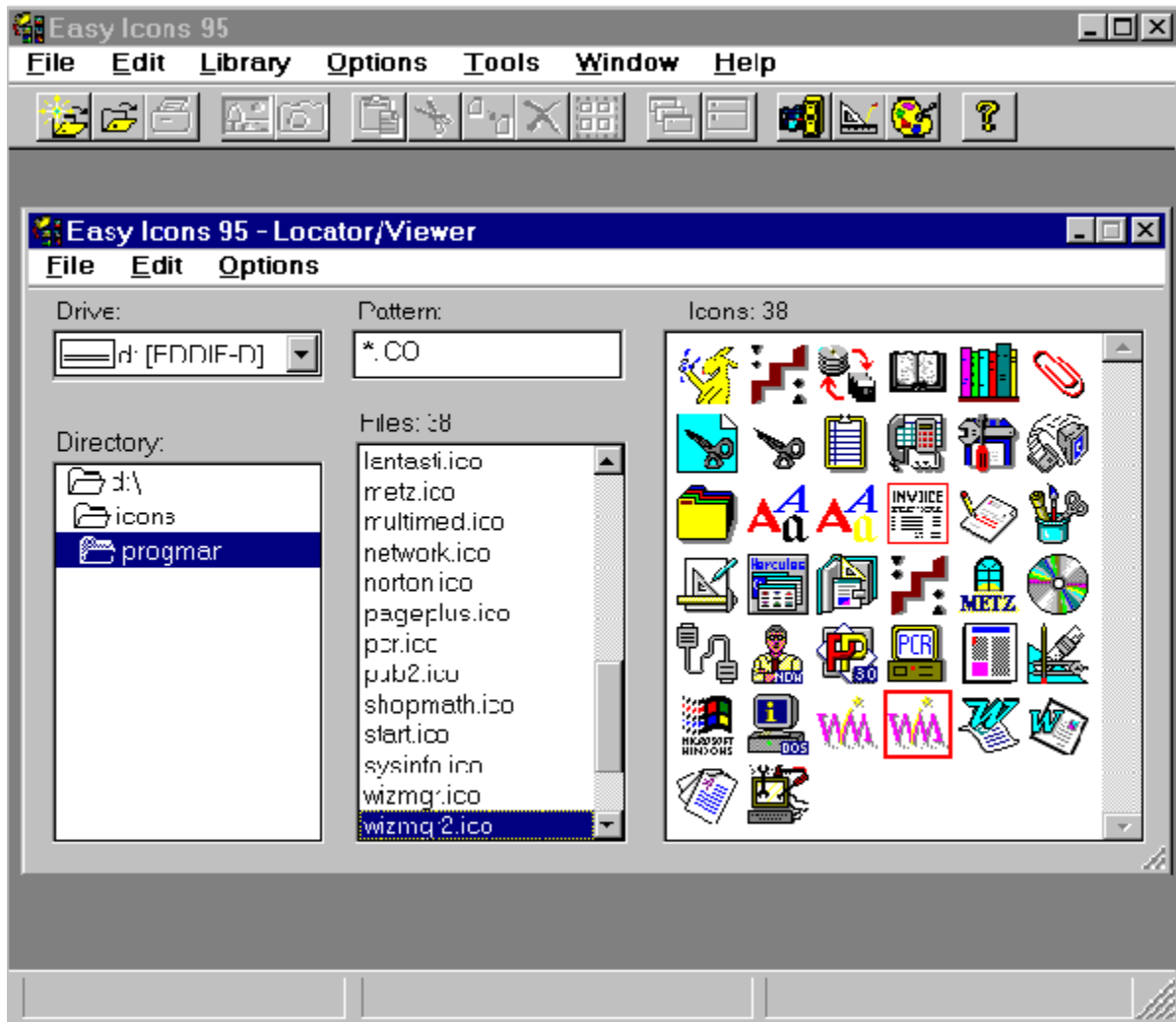

Icons are a fact of life when working with Windows. Whether you're still using Windows 3.1x or have ventured off into the unknown realms of Windows 95, icons are a very large part of the GUI aspect of Windows. This being the case, most Windows users have a sizable collection of icons and a variety of tools to create and manipulate their icons. Unfortunately however, few of us have an orderly method of working with icons. With the *Easy Icon 95* utility, any Windows user can have a complete icon management system, right at their fingertips, to help organize their icons.

Rather than having icons and icon utilities spread all over your system this versatile icon management utility offers you a way to organize your icons into any number of individual icon libraries. Instead of running around looking for your editing utilities, *Easy Icon 95* allows quick access to your favorite icon and graphics editors, from within the program. No more extracting an icon with one program and trying to figure out where the extractor utility put the ICO file while you open your icon editing utility.

This *Easy Icon 95* program allows you to view and extract icons from virtually any EXE, DLL, or similar file type that contains icons. Once the icon you desire is located, *Easy Icon 95* offers the choice of extracting and saving the icon as either ICO or BMP files. The icons in the ICO format can then be added to your icon libraries. Here the program will allow you to setup and organize your far-flung icons in a variety of organized ICL files. Extracting the icon images in the BMP format is especially useful for any applications where you need to make a copy of an icon to paste into a document.

You can also create and maintain your present icon collection in any number of different libraries. This library building process is actually quite simple. To setup a library of icons, all you need to do is create and name a new icon library. This library is then saved as an ICL file. Then you can use the **Icon Locator** utility within the *Easy Icon 95* program to search your complete system.



Once the desired icons are located, and extracted if necessary, you can simply drag and drop the icons into your new library. Icons can be added to libraries or copied between different libraries by just clicking and dragging the icon to the new location. Several icon libraries may be opened at the same time to allow you to organize your icons in whatever way you wish.

Though the *Easy Icon 95* utility is not an icon creator, it does function as a shell for your favorite icon editor and bitmap editor. Here you simply specify the location of your preferred icon editor and bitmap editor in the Options-Tool Directories menu. Then, when you need either of these utilities, you can either click the icon on the tool bar or use the Tools menu to load either of these programs.

If you're tired of trying to make sense of an otherwise disorganized system of keeping up with your icons, the *Easy Icon 95* program will definitely be a welcome addition to your system. The *Easy Icon 95* utility is optimized to run on Windows 95 systems. Though it will run in Windows 3.1 or 3.11, it may not appear correctly in these environments. Anyone not using Windows 95 should use the version of *Easy Icon* made for Windows 3.1/3.11 (EASYICON.ZIP)

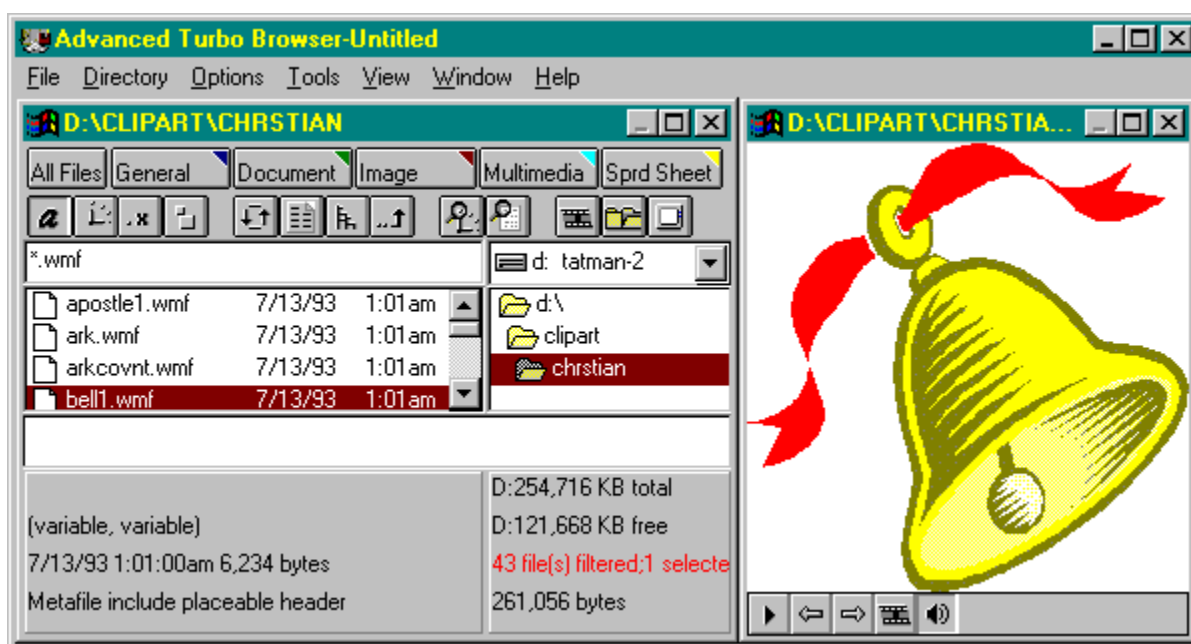

ADVANCED TURBO BROWSER

a review by Ted Tatman

Why is it that no matter how big a hard disk that you get, within a few months it seems as if it's filled to near capacity? What's all that stuff on your hard drive anyway? If you're suffering from too many computer goodies but too few free sectors left, then you might want to look into **Advanced Turbo Browser** from Pacific Gold Coast Corp. before you try to talk your spouse into getting yet another "necessary" hardware upgrade. ("But honey, didn't you buy a new hard drive LAST year?") **Advanced Turbo Browser** can help you see what most of that junk is on your system (and CD-ROMs too) and help you manage it as well. (Why is it "Advanced" Turbo Browser? Because the company had a smaller version of the program called just "Turbo Browser.")



Basically, **Advanced Turbo Browser** is a combination file manager, viewer and graphics converter. It supports most of the main types of files you're likely to come across, including:

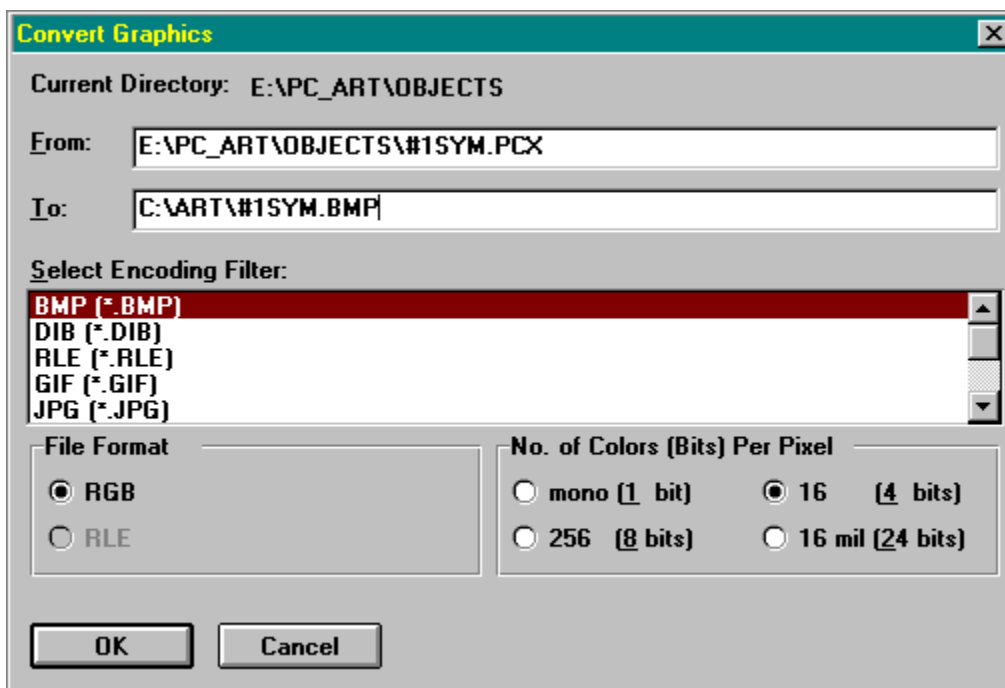

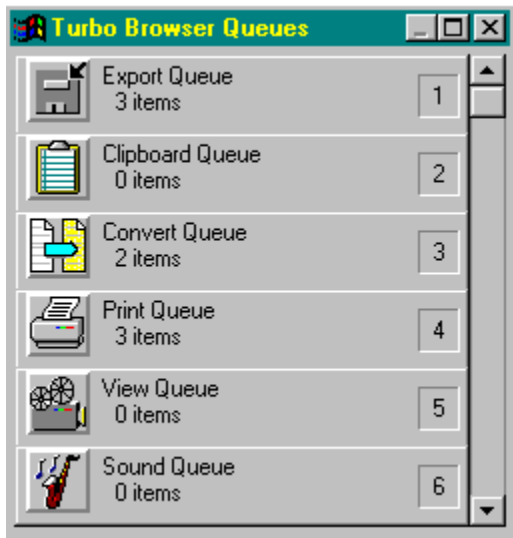

Advanced Turbo Browser does all the Move, Copy, Delete, Rename, etc., stuff you'd expect any decent file management program to do. And, it lets you find files by name or contents, including "fuzzy search" (best match). But where it really shines is its ability to automatically display the contents of any file as you scroll down the contents of a directory. If the file is in one of the formats it supports, you see it in the Viewer window (or in the case of sound files, you can play them from the Viewer window), almost as if you opened it up in its parent application. (If the file format is not supported, then you just see ASCII and junk characters.) You can even set the program to display the files automatically at a pre-determined interval, like a slide show. Now, you can finally figure out what all that clip art looks like without having to open and close each file one by one!



The next best thing about **Advanced Turbo Browser** is its image conversion capabilities. You can convert from one raster (bitmap) format to another, or convert vector (like WMF or CGM files) to raster formats. This comes in handy for "important stuff" like turning that cool WMF graphic into Windows wallpaper! You can even extract frames from full-motion animation, movie or video files and change them to BMP type files. Also, it's easy to extract ASCII contents from spreadsheet or document files, without having to open up the file's parent application (which you might not have), so you can convert these files to plain text (handy for sending over the Internet).



Advanced Turbo Browser has “Queues” that let you process multiple files at one time. There are Queues for Exporting, Conversion, Printing, Viewing and more. You can tag files from different directories and drives (and even servers, if you’re on a LAN), and then send them to the Queue of your choice for batch processing later. Also, the program lets you group files together in “virtual directories” that keeps you from physically moving all the files to one directory, or switching among two or more directories. For instance, I have WAV files in several directories on my system, but **Advanced Turbo Browser** lets me put them all in one virtual directory so that I could play them all back-to-back at one time.

Advanced Turbo Browser has plenty of cool little touches that make its operation easier, including toolbar tips and a surprising amount of right mouse button support for a pre-Windows 95 16-bit application. Browsing buttons let you limit the directory view for just the type of files you want, and they’re user configurable. (Which is good, because I couldn’t figure out why CGM, WMF and WPG files were listed as “General” files instead of “Image” files.) You have the option of calling up **Advanced Turbo Browser** from Windows own File Manager, plus the program has its own audio CD player applet as a bonus.

The 16-bit version of **Advanced Turbo Browser** performed fairly well on my system running the “Golden Build” of Windows 95. (Pacific Gold Coast expects to ship a 32-bit Win 95 version of the program on September 30, 1995.) The only major problem I experienced was in the viewing of True Type files. The program refused to view many of the TTF files in my Fonts directory (especially those from Swifte’s Typecase collections), showing just a blank screen. Also, when trying to view uninstalled TTF fonts from CD-ROMs, every font showed up looking just like Arial, even though the font names were correct. A real shame too, as it would be great to be able to use this program to see what all the fonts look like on those “2000 True Type Fonts” CD-ROMs. However, the company expects this problem to be corrected in the 32-bit version.

I also wished moving and copying files was a little easier. When you select the Move or Copy command, a dialog box comes up (just like in File Manager) that makes you have to type in the directory path where you’d like to move or copy the file. A “Browse” option would make

this a lot easier. You can't open up two or more directory windows like File Manager, but the program supports drag and drop so you could start up another instance of **Advanced Turbo Browser** and drag files between the two.

Advanced Turbo Browser needs 2 MB of free hard disk space (plus space for Video For Windows and QuickTime Video files if not already on your system) plus 2 MB of RAM. Pacific Gold Coast has said that if you buy the lower priced 16-bit version, you'll get a free upgrade to the 32-bit version when it's available.

Despite a couple of flaws, **Advanced Turbo Browser** does a lot of things well, including doing what any good utility program does: make computing life easier. There are better file managers, but the automatic file viewing can't be beat!

MICROHELP UNINSTALLER

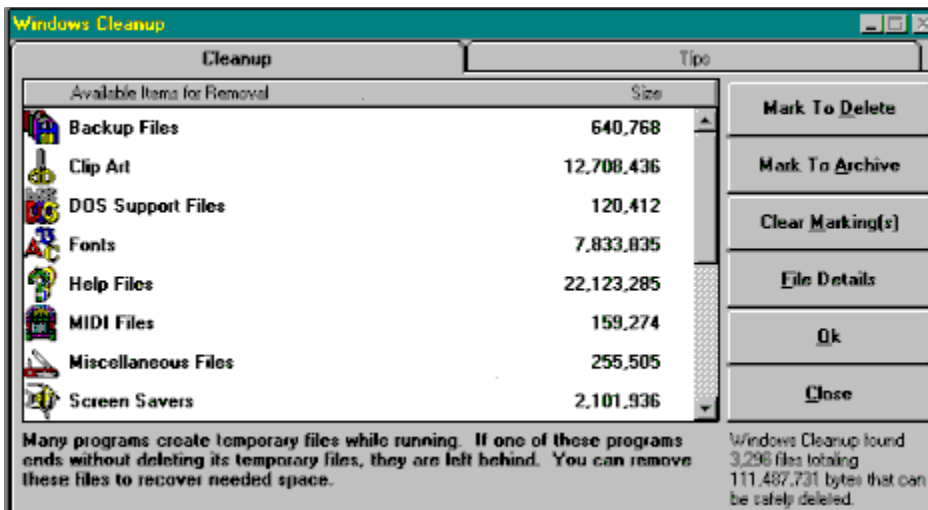
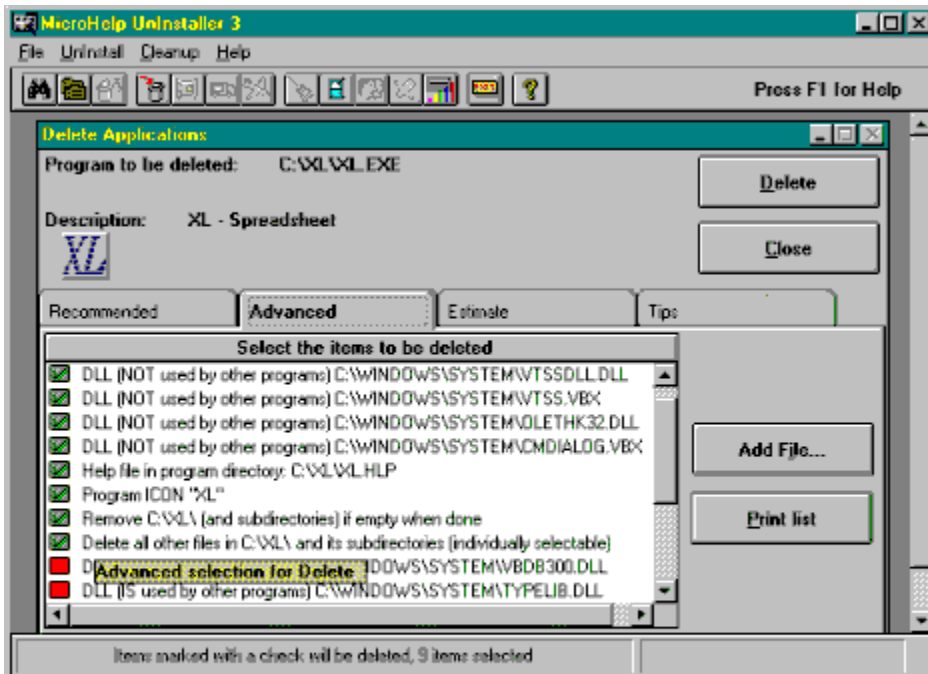

As a beta tester for Windows 95, I've been running Microsoft's new operating system exclusively on my home system since late 1994. Most all of my applications ran just fine on Win95. But, I was sad to find out that MicroHelp's UnInstaller 2 (which I reviewed in WOLR #91) did not. It, like many utilities that are closely tied to the Windows 3.x way of things, refused to perform satisfactorily with Win95. And, once you get used to having such a cool program that helps keep unwanted junk off your hard drive, you really miss it. So, it was with great enthusiasm that I obtained a copy of the latest version, 3.0, which MicroHelp guarantees to work with Windows 95.

One note before we go any further: **UnInstaller 3** works best with 16-bit applications. It might not accurately uninstall the new generation of Windows 95 compatible 32-bit applications. But, chances are that nearly all of the programs you run are 16-bit, especially if you're still running Windows 3.x. And, MicroHelp is expected to release a 32-bit version of the program this fall, which should safely uninstall both 16 and 32-bit Windows software. (However, true Win95 compatible applications are *supposed* to be fully uninstallable through Win95's Control Panel.)

This release's major improved feature is SmartLinks. SmartLinks scans your system the first time **UnInstaller 3** is run (and every time changes on your system have been made) and looks at every executable file and all references these files have to DLL and other interdependent files. It keeps all this information in a database that the program uses to make sure *every* file associated with an application can be safely uninstalled. Warning: the SmartLinks search process can take a long time. When it starts, go into the kitchen for a snack, because your computer might be tied up for awhile. (You needed to take a break anyway, right?) However, with the loss of speed, you should be getting a much safer uninstall this way. (Version 2.0 had a tendency to miss some files, and the new version of SmartLinks fixes this by determining "with near 100% accuracy" which files are related to each other.) By the way, a faster version of SmartLinks should be available by the time you read this, which will shorten the time it takes SmartLinks to run.

UnInstaller 3 has several new features over its previous version. Before, deleting files was UnInstaller's main purpose. Now, besides deletion, you have the choice to move applications completely to another directory or drive, with all related files and settings intact. Or, you can compress and archive infrequently used programs to save disk space. Plus, **UnInstaller's** Transport function lets you gather an application and all related files for use on another PC, like a laptop or home computer.



The new version of **UnInstaller** has beefed up many of 2.0's features. Now, its Duplicate File Finder locates *true* duplicate files, as well as files of similar, date and size. The Orphan Finder now uses enhanced fuzzy logic to find files that aren't related to any others on the system, and searches your whole computer, not just *whatever's* in the Windows shell (Program Manager, Explorer, Norton Desktop, etc.) you happen to be using. Windows Cleanup now finds more types of files, including fonts, clip art, screen savers, sounds and temp files, that could be clogging up your system. Plus, MicroHelp has included improved File Viewers to let you look at files in the original formats before uninstalling.

Running the final "golden build" of Windows 95, I did find a few little quirks when using

UnInstaller 3. It didn't recognize any programs that were in two folders down (like the "Games" group inside "Accessories"), or programs that weren't in folders, but had icons on the desktop or on the Start bar. Plus, this 16-bit version of **UnInstaller** doesn't recognize the long file names that Win95 supports. But these shouldn't be a problem if you use **UnInstaller 3** on a Windows 3.x system. MicroHelp has said that they will be releasing a patch file (available for download from their BBS) within 90 days of Win95's official release to assure maximum compatibility.

Overall, I found **UnInstaller 3** to be a very cool and competent program. Like every good utility, after you use it for awhile, you wonder how you ever lived without it! If you have version 2.0, there's enough new useful stuff to make the upgrade worthwhile. If you're not planning to move to Windows 95 anytime soon and are looking for a great way to reclaim some of your precious hard disk space, then **UnInstaller 3** deserves a serious look. But, if you are upgrading to Win95, you might want to wait for the 32-bit version, which should be available soon. However, I for one, am glad to have it now. Like Windows 95, it's not perfect, but it's a *lot* closer than it used to be!

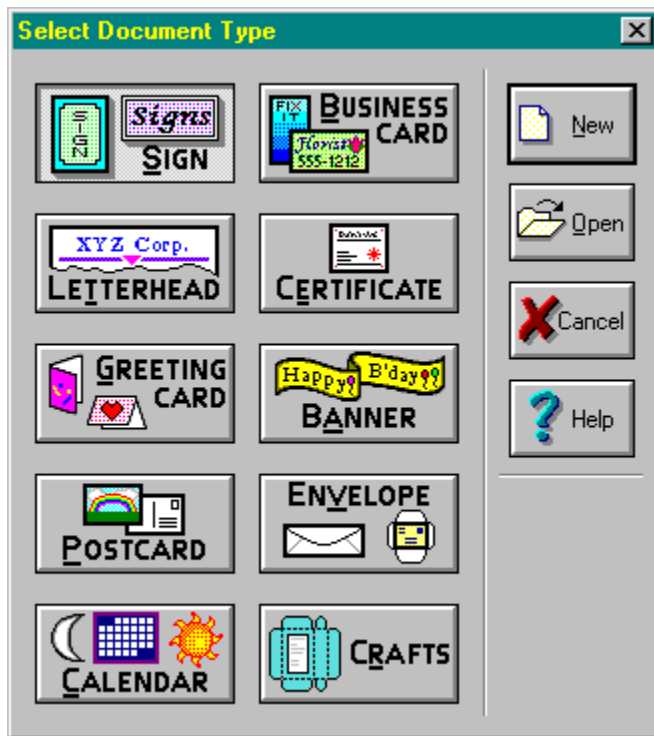

PRINT ARTIST

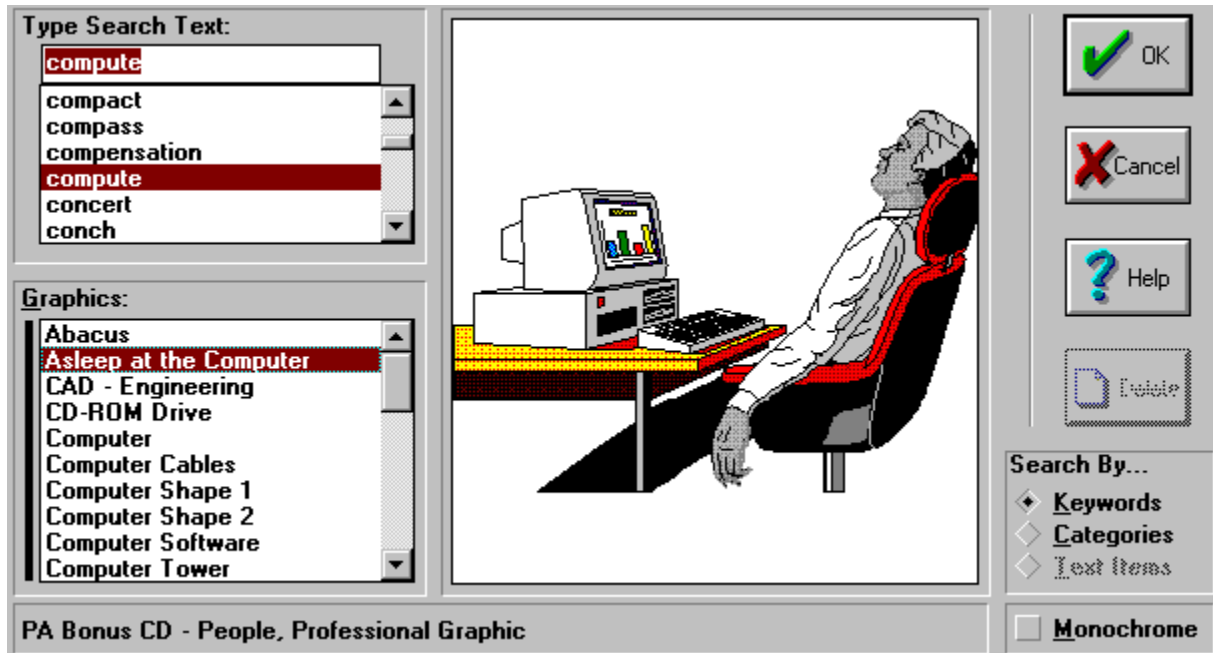

Let me start off by saying what thousands of other people already know: **Print Artist 2.5** (the CD-ROM edition for Windows) is a *very* cool program. Sure, there are other programs for creating greeting cards, signs, stationery, etc., aimed at the home and small business computer user, but **Print Artist 2.5** is the best I've seen. From its simple and attractive interface to its high quality clip art and special effects, this product is a winner. No problems running it in Windows 95, either!



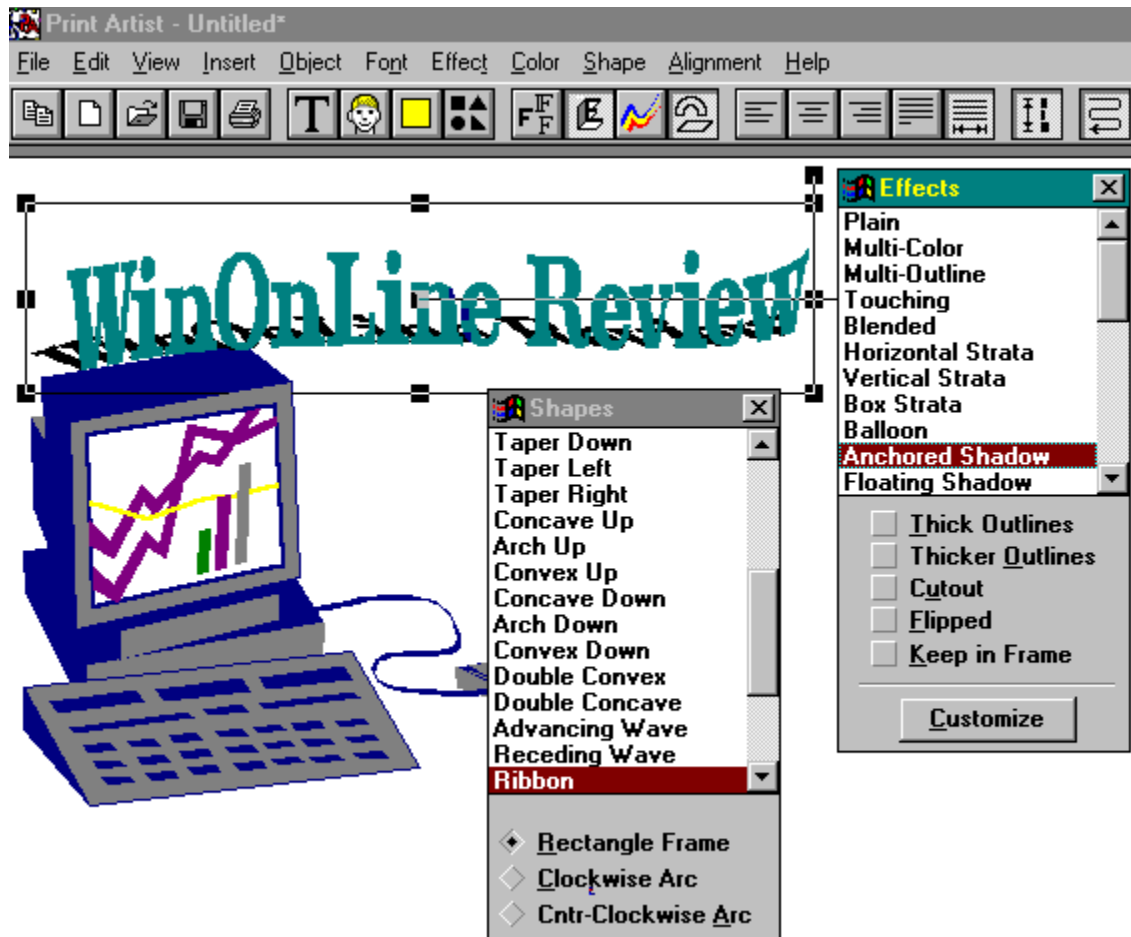
When you start up **Print Artist**, you see a selection box that lets you choose from 8 different types of documents to create or open. Select one, and you're taken to another selection box where you decide if you want to start with a blank page, a template, or a pre-designed layout.

Print Artist comes with dozens of templates and hundreds of pre-designed layouts, all professionally done. The layouts are great for idea-starters, or can be used "as-is" or with minor changes.



There are thousands of high-quality clip-art images that come with **Print Artist 2.5** (over 2,300 on the program's CD-ROM, plus another 1,500 on a bonus CD-ROM). All are vector-based, so they can be as small or large as you want and still look great. All graphics come in libraries (several images to a file) with the GFX extension, but individual pictures can be easily exported to other formats (WMF, TIF, BMP and EPS) so you can use the art in other applications. Images are managed internally by a feature called the "Graphics Grabber" that displays and organizes the program's artwork. In addition, you can import TIF, GIF, EPS, BMP, PCX and WMF files.

Print Artist lets you use all the TrueType or ATM fonts on your system, plus it has 100 of its own fonts (which are available only from within the program). If you don't already have *enough* TrueType fonts in your collection, 150 are furnished on the bonus CD-ROM.



Images and fonts are a breeze to manage on screen, just by selecting an object and moving it or resizing it with the object's "handles." **Print Artist** supplies a multitude of special effects that can be applied to both; the font effects are especially impressive. I found the easiest way to access the special effects are through the Palette windows. The Palettes (which let you scroll through their options) can be dragged to any part of the Desktop for quick use any time you need them. If you move them away from the Toolbar, they stay open on screen until you close them. Very handy!

Along with Text and Graphics, you can insert fill objects (good for setting off both graphics and text, as well as for filling in white space) and basic geometric shapes. The program doesn't have any real drawing tools, but they aren't missed. I could never draw anything on a computer screen that didn't look like something a 4-year old would do with fingerpaints, anyway!

One of my favorite things about **Print Artist** is its ability to switch to and stay in monochrome mode. Because some colors translate to the same shade of gray when converted to monochrome, it furnishes special monochrome versions of all layouts and graphics in its libraries. This lets you create documents that print better on monochrome printers than color layouts or graphics that have been converted to monochrome. If your final input is going to a

black-and-white printer, this really helps you see exactly what your creation is *really* going to look like. Or, when you print, use the "coloring book" option. Your creation will print out in outline mode, just like a coloring book. You can add the colors by hand, or make unlimited amounts of pictures for your kids to color. Cool!

Another neat thing about **Print Artist** is its Quotation library. It contains a variety of quotations from famous people ready to be inserted into your creation with the click of a button. Here's one of my favorites: "It ain't those parts of the Bible that I can't understand that bother me, it is the parts that I do understand." (Mark Twain)

Print Artist, developed by The Pixellite Group, was published by Maxis, but Pixellite was purchased by Sierra On-Line earlier this year. In July, Sierra On-Line started distributing and selling **Print Artist**. Smart move on Sierra's part!

How good is it really? Well, after spending a couple of hours with it, I immediately uninstalled a couple of similar applications from my hard drive and sent them to my brother-in-law! **Print Artist** is easy to use, with great looking output. It's worth the price just for the cool clipart.

HYPERBIBLE

a review by Ed Hoffman

Ever since Johannes Gutenberg invented movable type, in the 15th century, no single item has been printed or reprinted as much as the Bible. In fact, the first book ever printed with movable type was the Bible. Since that time, the Bible has been printed in many versions and in every language ever known to mankind. Today, the printed Bible is still found virtually everywhere. Anyone who travels, knows that a copy of the Bible is in every hotel room in the United States and in many countries around the world. Likewise, every US airline has a copy of the Bible in every airplane.

Today, with the advances made in electronic communication, digital Bibles are also widely available. Like their printed cousins, these Bibles are also found in a variety of different forms and versions. Just about every on-line service and bulletin board system in the world has some type of Bible program available on-line. However, despite the popularity of these Bible variations, few of us sit down and try to read this volume as a novel. Rather, most of us simply look up different topics. The tool most often employed for these searches is a concordance. A concordance is simply a listing of various key words and their locations in the Bible. For those with more demanding requirements, there are several different study or reference works to help the reader find what they want. One of the best available is the **Thompson Chain Reference Bible**. This volume uses both a concordance and a chain reference to find information. This chain reference can best be described as a concordance of topic, concepts, or ideas, rather than simply listing key words.

Though the printed version of this Bible variation greatly assisted many Bible students, it still takes a considerable amount of time and effort to study any topic. Now, however, with the *HyperBible 3.0 - CD* both the serious Bible student and the occasional Bible reader will be able to spend much less time searching for information. By combining the functionality of the chain reference principle with the speed of a computer, these searches are virtually instantaneous and considerably more *user friendly* than ever before.

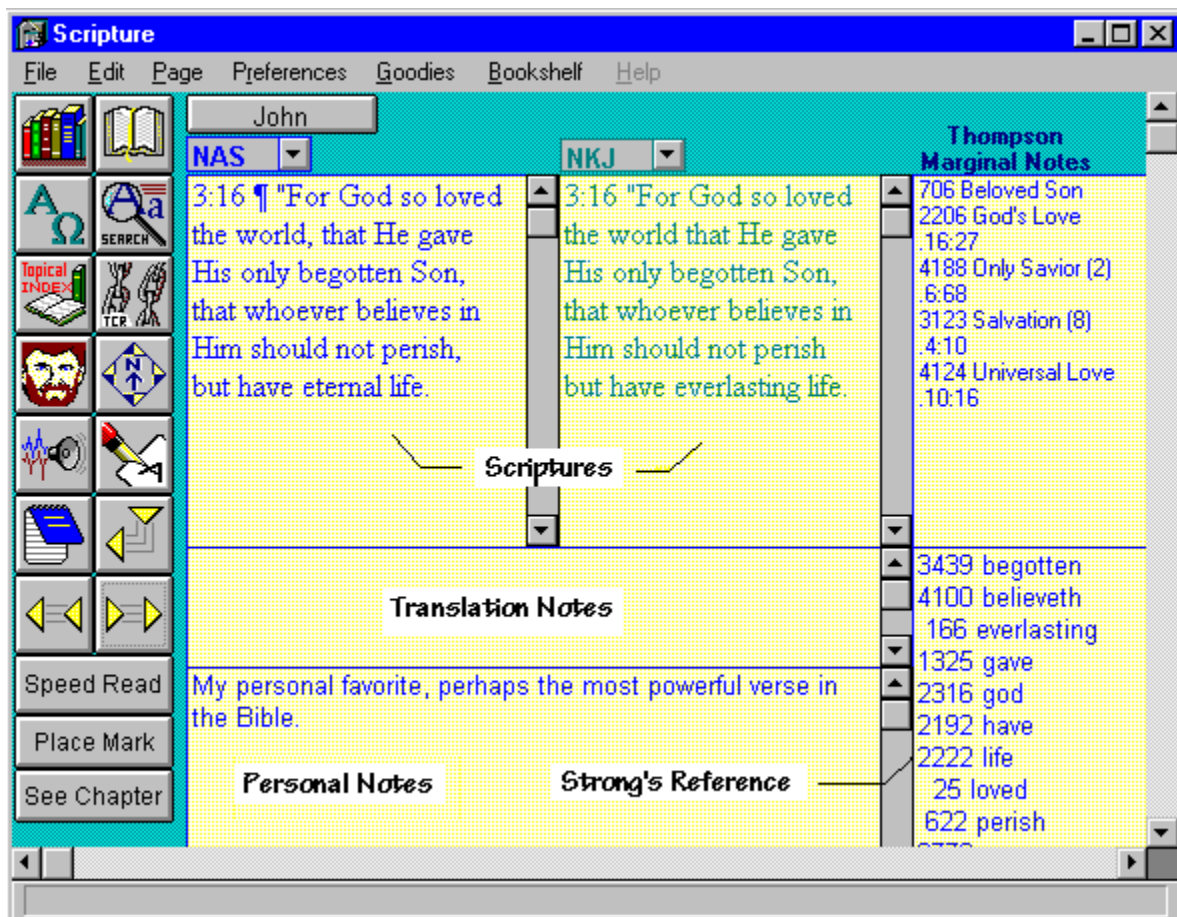
Several months back I reviewed an earlier edition of the *HyperBible*. I found this CD to be a very comprehensive and useful tool. With the new 3.0 version, all the functionality and usefulness of the earlier editions are retained and expanded. Several features have been added to aid both the serious and novice student. Regardless of the user's familiarity with the Bible, just about everyone can benefit from using this CD.

The *HyperBible 3.0* is a computerized version of the *Thompson Chain-Reference Bible*. Anyone familiar with the printed version of this volume as well as those who have yet to use this study tool will be quite impressed with this program. The program operates through a self-contained run time version of the *Asymetrix Toolbook* program. This adaptation of the new **Toolbook** program offers a considerable array of capabilities and functionality.

The *HyperBible 3.0* program is available in two basic variations: on floppy disks and on a CD. The disk version is available with any of six translations. The CD version is available in

three variations. The CD Master Edition Plus is the subject of this review. This CD contains all six available translations as well as the Strong's Hebrew and Greek Concordance. The six translations furnished with the program are: New American Standard (NAS), King James Version (KJV), New International Version (NIV), New King James Version (NKJ), Revised Standard Version (RSV) and the Living Bible, Paraphrase (LIV).

When the *HyperBible* program starts, the Main Menu is the first window that appears. This window is shown as a bookshelf. This screen simplifies the process of navigating the program. The various areas of the program, are shown with different volumes on the bookshelf. Simply clicking on one of the books automatically opens the program to one of the eight different areas or functions. These eight areas, or functions, may also be accessed through the menu bar.



The main screen of the program is the Bible section. This shows the specific verses in either one or two translations. Though six translations are available, only two can be shown at a single time with the program. The translations can be changed very easily and should you wish, you can easily compare the same verse, or verses, in all six translations very easily. When ordering the program on floppies, you'll need to specify the translation, or translations, you desire. If, however, you order the CD Master Edition Plus version, all six are available to you. Switching between different translations is also quite simple. All you'll need to do is click on the arrow beside the translation abbreviation at the top of each window. A box then appears with all

the installed translations. The primary translation is shown to the left and the secondary is to the right. The primary version is used for concordance searches unless you specify the secondary to be used.



The *Bible* section screen contains a wide range of options. All the various areas and functions of the program are easily accessed through the double row of icons shown down the left side of the window. These icons are visible in all the different areas of the program so moving back and forth between the different sections is quite easy and very fast. The function of each of these features is relatively easy to determine. However, there are a few notable features in each of these areas. The *Topical Index*, for example, lists over 7,000 topics. Here you simply type in the word or topic you desire and the program takes you to the general index. Here a simple click on any entry takes to a dialog box showing that topic and all Bible references. Another click on the specific verse opens that verse in the window. Clicking on the Thompson Chain Reference icon allows you to enter the reference number. This will then take you to another dialog box where all the Bible references are listed. Here again, a simple click on any scriptural reference instantly opens that verse.

Another novel and unique feature of the program is the pronunciation of Old Testament names. Now you'll no longer need to guess at how these names should be pronounced, just click on this icon and a listing of 130 names found in the Old Testament appears. Everyone from Abiezer to Zibeon is listed. Simply click on a specific name and you'll hear how it is properly pronounced. You can also create your own *Personal Topics* with the program. Here you can setup you own personal listings of your study references. The *Word Processor* icon allows you instant access to your word processor. Here you can copy information from the *HyperBible* into you own documents.

The window directly below the scripture in main Bible screen also shows any translation notes. Typically, these notes detail or describe the meaning of selected words or phrases used for a specific translation. Directly below this window is a space for you to enter your own personal notes. To enter data here all you need to do is place the cursor in the windows and begin to type. This is ideal for recording quick notes or any ideas you might have.

At the far right of the screen are the Thompson Chain Reference numbers and topics. To access these references, simply click on the number or topic description. You are then taken to the a listing of every Bible verse that references that topic. Directly below this area on the screen is the Strong's Hebrew and Greek concordance. Like the Thompson Chain Reference section, this area shows a listing of words and numbers. Clicking on any entry here takes you to the Strong's concordance dictionary where the definition of the word is shown along with all the places in the Bible where the word appears.

The *Atlas* area of the program contains a variety of maps to help find the various geographic features. An index is also provided to find specific places. To use this feature, simply click the index icon and find the name of the place or feature you want to find. Click on this name and a map appears with the place or feature highlighted. For additional study, simply click on the appropriate map entry and the program jumps to the chain-reference information about that place or feature.

The *HyperBible* is a program that takes full advantage of the power of the computer as well as the features of the *Toolbook* program. Even if your Bible study requirements are minimal, the *HyperBible 3.0 - CD Master Edition Plus Version* is a program that will definitely help you make the best use of your study time. This program will operate in all versions of the Windows operating system (3.1, 3.11, and Windows 95).

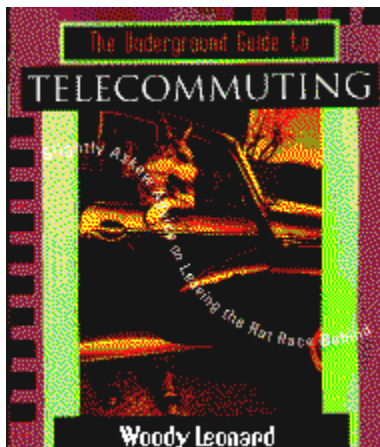
THE UNDERGROUND GUIDE TO TELECOMMUTING

a review by Bob Gollihur

It's the trend. Listen to the experts, the futurists, or better yet, take notice of the world around you. Before long, the entire world will either be working at home or be part-timers for several companies.

Ye of the Corporate World, I know of what I speak. After 23 years in cubicles and plush offices, I have joined the ranks. I gaze across my sparse lawn, waiting for the mailman to come, the phone to ring, or some other exciting occurrence, while I *telecommute*. Sounds a bit better than 'working at home,' which no one ever believed anyone actually did.

There are tactical, emotional, practical, and mechanical aspects to such a move. Woody Leonard seems to have thought about them all. **The Underground Guide to Telecommuting - Slightly Askew Advice on Leaving the Rat Race Behind** is a treasure trove of real world advice from someone who has been there — for several years, in fact.



Woody addresses every issue I could think of. He starts off with some background, including a remarkable two-paragraph history of Western Culture, and discusses the *Cyburbs*. From there we move to the practical: office placement, organization, furniture, computer and other equipment. From there, he moves to chapters on the Teleemployee and Teleboss, and transitions to consultant, freelancer, etc.

The evil triplets, Tax, Laws, and Accounting follow, and then we move into the futurist Woody, with a brief visit to making cyberbucks, comments on The Virtual Corporation, and a few pages looking into his personal crystal ball. Finally, a couple of appendices provides resources for setting up a telecommuting program, resources, and contact information for the many references in the book.

If you haven't read any of Woody's other books, you're in for a treat. Not only does his style make the read enjoyable, but the whole subject approachable. The text is sprinkled with quotations and cartoon drawings, and you benefit from his missteps and experience. Without going into useless details, he explains such things as the mysteries of ISDN and other telephone

secrets, taking me to just the informational plane I wanted to fly on: I now know *enough to be dangerous*.

The Underground Guide to Telecommuting is not just for the employee becoming a telecommuter, but chock full of good information and advice for any home-based business. Not only that, it's a fun read that can make *you* dangerous, too.

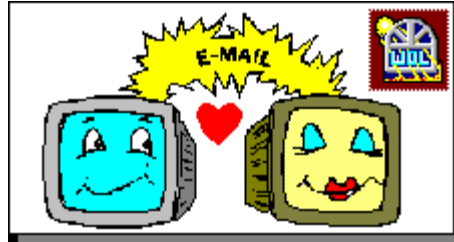

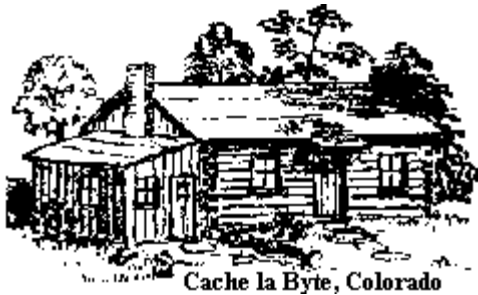
