

Win-Align

(Release 1.0 -- October 19, 1995)

Win-Align is an easy-to-use utility for aligning and sizing windows to give your desktop a neat, clean-looking appearance. It works with both top level windows and MDI child windows.

Alignment Options:

- * Place selected window(s) in the upper left, upper right, lower left, or lower right corners.
- * Align selected windows along their top, bottom, left, or right edges.
- * Space selected windows the same number of pixels apart, either vertically or horizontally.

Sizing Options:

- * Make selected windows the same height, width, or both.

Undo Changes:

- * Up to 10 levels of "undo" are supported.

INSTALLING WIN-ALIGN

1. Create a new subdirectory C:\WINALIGN (or choose your own disk and subdirectory name).

2. Copy the following files to this new subdirectory:

- WINALIGN.EXE
- WINALIGN.WRI

3. Copy the file CTL3D.DLL to your windows system directory (usually C:\WINDOWS\SYSTEM). If this file already exists you do not need to copy this file; however, if you receive garbled output in some dialog boxes you should use the supplied CTL3D.DLL instead of the already present file.

4. Create a new group in your Windows Program Manager (e.g. "Win-Align").

5. Create new program entries for the following files in the WINALIGN subdirectory:

- WINALIGN.EXE (The program file)
- WRITE WINALIGN.WRI (Documentation in Windows Write format)
