The Main Window of Writer's Cramp Database Maintenance is where Letter databases can be compressed, repaired, and deleted. Compressing a Letter database can reduce the amount of disk space the Letter database is using. If a Letter database gets corrupted, the repair Letter option may fix the damage. A backup database is created when a Letter database is compressed. The backup database is to provide a backout in case a newly compressed database does not work properly. If the newly compressed Letter database works properly, the backup Letter database can be deleted to free up disk space.

The EXIT button will end Writer's Cramp Database Maintenance.

The about window displays the copyright notice and the version.release number of Writer's Cramp. Click on the About Window to close the window.

The Compress Letter Database Window is where a Letter database can be selected to be compressed. Compressing a database can free up disk space used by the database. When a Letter database is compressed, a backup of the database is created before the compression.

The COMPRESS LETTER DATABASE button will compress the selected Letter database and create a backup database.

The EXIT button will close the window and return to the Main window.

B Delete Letter Backup Window

The Delete Letter Backup Database Window displays a list of all Letter backup databases. These backup databases can be deleted to free up disk space.

The DELETE LETTER BACKUP button will delete the selected backup Letter database.

The EXIT button will close the window and return to the Main window.

Repair Letter Database Window

The Repair Letter Database Window is where a corrupted Letter database can possibly be fixed.

The REPAIR LETTER DATABASE button will run a repair process on the selected Letter database.

The EXIT button will close the window and return to the Main window.

Delete Letter Database Window

The Delete Letter Database Window is where a Letter database can be deleted. A deleted Letter database can NOT be recovered.

The DELETE LETTER DATABASE button will delete the selected Letter database.

The EXIT button will close the window and return to the Main window.

Enter the password of the selected Letter database. The selected Letter database or its backup will not be deleted unless the correct password is entered.

The CHECK button will validate the password entered. If the password is valid, then the Letter database or its backup is deleted.

The EXIT button will close the window and return to the Main window.
