Private Music Collection

Private Music Collection is a database to gather information about your Music Collection. Private Music Collection is meant for use at home. It can cointain up to 8000 records.

You can use Private Music Collection together with MC Cover Builder. MC Cover Builder supports the database made by Private Music Collection.

The Database

Records

Creating a database

When you start Private Music Collection for the first time you'll have to create a new database. You can create a database by clicking the New button or selecting New from the menu option File. Choose the directory where you want to create the database and enter a filename using eight caracters. An extension is not needed.

Opening a database

To open an excisting database, click on the Open button or select Open from the menu option File. Then select the diretory where the database is located and select the database or enter it's name.

PMC can also open a database at startup. Make a new icon that starts PMC and add the filename with path as parameter. You don't need to enter an extension.

Closing a database

Before you can open or create a database you must close the database that is currently open. To close your database Click the Close button or select Close from the menu option File.

PMC will close the database automaticly when you close PMC. Do never shut down the computer without closing the database. You may lose information or even loose the whole database. PMC will close all open files wyhen you close Windows.

General Information

The database of PMC uses three files: the index named <database>.dx, <database>.cd containing the general information about your albums and <database>.sg with information about the songs on the albums. Every record in the database will use approximately 2.5 kB diskspace. The space used changes with the number of songs entered.

The images you can display in PMC are always displayed at a size of 125×125 pixels. A Windows BMP image of 125×125 pixels will use about 50 kB diskspace. You can save diskspace by using a small pallette or by saving the image at 100×100 pixels.

PMC is able to recover a lot of accidents that can happen to your datbase. But in some cases some of your records will be lost. Using PMC and your computer the way you should can save you a lot of troubles. I also want to advise you to keep a backup of the database.

Searching a record

Inserting a new record

Before you can enter the data of a new record you'll have you click on the Insert button. Otherwise you will overwrite the data of the record currently displayed. When you click on the Insert button you get an empty screen. You must enter the fields Artist and Title before you can save the record. Before you can enter the songs you must enter the soundcarrier and the number of disks or tapes on the Details tab.

The data you have entered will automaticly be saved when you start any action. You don't need to save anything. Just be sure to close PMC properly when you are finished!

Editing a record

You can always change a record. Search the record you want to change and enter the field you want to change.

Artist and Title

Before you can save the record, you must enter the name of the Artist and the Title of the album. You will start at the Artist field and when you are finished press <TAB> to move on to Title.

Genre

You can select the Genre from the list in the combo box, but you can also enter it yourself. If you have registered your copy of PMC you are able to edit your Genre list in the menu Options.

Producer/Composer

The field with the default name Producer can the used to enter the name of the producer or componist of the entire album. If you want to enter the composer just select that field name by pulling down the combobox and selecting Composer. You can enter the producer or composer of each different song in the songlist.

Label

The field Label is meant to enter the name of the record company that released this album.

Released

The field **Released** contains the date when the album is released. You cn enter the year, but also the excat date.

The tab Details

The data on this tab is used to manage some things in the database. So read the following carefully when you have some problems.

Soundcarrier

You can select one of the sound carriers by clicking on it. This field is required to enter the tracks or songs of on the album.

Number of Disks/Tapes

If you enter the number of disks or tapes you can specify on which Disks or tape a song is located. This field is required when you want to enter all songs.

Show Artist Of Song

When you have an album with songs from multiple atrists you can check the Show Artist Of

Exporting data

Song box. Now you can enter the artist of each song in the songlist. This box can be checked by default when you choose Show Artist Of Each Song in the Options menu.

Show Producer/Composer

This field works the same way as Show Artist Of Song. You can also have it checked as default by selecting Show Producer Or Componist Of Each Song.

Load Track Times

By pressing on this button the times of all songs will be loaded from the Audio CD in the CD-ROM player. Make sure you have the right CD inserted. When you have multiple CD's you will be prompted for the next one. It is best to do this before you edit the Track List. When you have already entered the tracks the times will added to the song with the same track number. When the number of tracks is not the same as the number of tracks in the list you will get an error. This can also happen when there is a secret track on the CD.

The tab Additional

This tab contains some additional data, you don't need to enter it.

ID Number

This field can be used to enter your own code for the album or a location in your racks.

Obtained By

In this field you can enter from whow you got this album.

Lend To

When other people often borrow your CD's you can keep track of your CD's by entering here who has the CD at this moment.

Image File

This is only available in the registered version of PMC. By pressing the button you can choose an image. The filename can't be longer than eight caracters and the image has to be of the Windows bitmap format. The images must be located in the same directory as the database they belong to. When an image is missing PMC won't prompt you it just can't show the image. You can give friends a copy of your database without the images.

Remarks

Here you can enter some notes up to 256 caracters.

The tab *Tracks*

This tab contains the tracks on the album. If you click on the list to enter the data. If you can't enter the data chect the tab **Details** again.

The Track List

To enter the songs you must select the Soundcarrier and give the number of disks or tapes. It's also possible to insert more songs afterward if you want to. If you forgot a song then you can insert it between two other songs by pressing <SHIFT>-<INSERT>. To delete a song you can press <SHIFT>-<DELETE>. Use <TAB> to move to the next cell. When you don't want the automatic data to be entered use the arrow keys to move. When you are in the last column of the last row a new row will be added when you press <TAB>.

Searching a record

Records Printing Records Exporting data

To look up a record click the Search button. A dialogbox will open where you can enter the searchstring and the field to search. The options Artist and Title are the fastest way to search the database. The other options are slower because PMC has to read from the disk for these options. You can also enable search in deleted records if you want to. All records found will be placed in the Search list and unless you check the Don't prompt box you get a prompt for every matching record. When the search action is finished you can find all matching records in the Search List.

You can <u>print</u> the records that are gathered in the Search List.

Printing Records

Records Searching a record

Selecting a font for your printer

PMC enables you to select a font for your printer. To do so Select Printer Font in the File menu. All your installed fonts can be selected. The font size is limited to a range from 10 to 14.

To install a font as default select **Default Printer Font** in the **Options** menu. Use **Save Settings** to save it as default for later sessions.

Printing

You can print three different lists.

- The first one is the whole list. To do so select the radiobutton Whole List and check the data you want to be printed;
- The second option is to print a part of your list. To do so, you first have to <u>search</u> for records. Then you can choose Print and select <u>Search List</u> to print the records in the Search List;
- The last option you can print is the Current Record. Select this option and check all data you want to be printed.

When you are not sure if whether the printer setup is correct or not, check it by clicking on the Setup button.

After you have made your choice click on the OK button.

Exporting data Searching a record

<u>Records</u>

You can export three different lists.

- The first one is the whole list. To do so select the radiobutton Whole List;
- The second option is to print a part of your list. To do so, you first have to <u>search</u> for records. Then you can choose Export ASCII from the File menu and select Search List to export the records in the Search List;
- The last option you can print is the Current Record.

After you have chosen the list you want to be generated, select the directory and a file name to export the data to.

Playing a CD

Load Track Information

The CD player in PMC will only work properly when you have both a CD-ROM and a soundcard. If one of these doesn't work properly PMC will prompt you with an error message when you start PMC and the CD display will say 'NOT READY'. To play a CD audio you must connect the audio cable between the CD-ROM and your soundcard properly. Otherwise it might look as if the CD is playing but you won't hear any music.

You can play the CD by using the buttons beneath the display. Another option to play the CD is by double clicking on one of the tracks on the Track list. This will only work when you have Loaded the Track Information from the CD itself.

When Windows own CD player takes over control you can disable it with Tweak UI in your control panel.

You can uncheck Play Audio CDs automaticly on the tab Paranoia.

If you don't have Tweak UI you can download if for free at serveral major FTP sites and Mircosoft.

Press the button to start Tweak UI now.

{button Switch off CD-player, EF(`tweakui.cpl', `Tweak UI', 10)}

Editing The Genrelist

To edit the Genrelist choose Edit Genrelist in the menu Options. You will see a window with the current genres in the list. You can insert new genres and delete genres the same way as in a normal editor. Every genre must be on a next line. The Genres will be shown in the order you enter them. This enables you to place the Genre you need the most on top of the list.

It's best to keep the size of the Genrelist small by removing Genres you seldom or never use.

Options

Purge Records At Close

When this option is checked all deleted records will be removed from the database when the database is being closed. Default: Not Checked.

Sort Records At Close

Checking this option means that all records will automaticly be sorted when you close the database. Default: Checked.

Show Artists Of Each Song

When you check this option the option Show Artist Of Each Song will be checked by default. Default: Not Checked.

Show Producer Or Composer Of Each Song

When you check this option the option Show Producer will be checked by default. Default: Not Checked.

Use Producer As Default

Use Producer As Default will show the Producer field in the header. By clicking this option it this option will change to Use Componist As Default. In that case the field is used to enter the name of the componist. Default: Use Producer As Default.

Convert First Letter Of Every Word To Caps

Checking this option will convert the first letter of every word you enter to a Capital. Default: Not Checked.

Edit Genre List

With this option you can adjust the <u>Genre List</u> to your own needs. The changes will be saved by <u>clicking OK</u> in the Gerne List Dialog box.

Sort By Artist And Album Title

Checking this option will sort the albums of one Artist by the title of the Albums in alphabethical order. When you check this option Sort By Artist And Release Date will be unchecked. Default: Checked.

Sort By Artist And Release Date

This option is the opposite of the option above. This time the albums of an artist will be sorted by release date. Checking this option wil uncheck Sort By Artist And Album Title. Default: Not Checked.

Default Printer Font

Use this option to set your default Printer font. Don't forget to save it with save settings for use in future sessions.

Save Settings This option is only available when changes to the options are made. Click on it to save the changes you've made for future sessions.

Registering

When you register you will recieve a temporary key that gives you 30 uncrippled starts. During that time you can try all options. After 21 days you will recieve your personal key. You can enter it in the Help menu. During those 21 days you can do a back order. If you do not backorder within 21 days after registering, you agree that you have bought PMC and that you can't do a backorder anymore.

Registered Version

Private use

A registered version of PMC may be used on any computer inside your house. To be clear: You have to register once to use as many copies as you like on computers inside your own house for private use.

Organisations, professionals and commercial use

Organisations of any type or individuals using PMC for commercial purposes must register for each copy they want to use. You may access the registered version of PMC through a network, provided that you have obtained individual licenses for the software covering all workstations that will access the software through the network. For instance, if 8 different workstations will access PMC on the network, each workstation must have its own PMC license, regardless of whether they use PMC at different times or concurrently.

License Information Support

To use all abilities of PMC you have to regiser it. Basicly you can register in two ways: with creditcard or without creditcard.

The price of one copy of PMC is US\$ 25. To recieve the latest version on disk you have an additional US\$ 10. To pay with international cheques you have to add US\$ 5 for the extra costs. There are no extra costs for payment with Eurocheques. For creditcard orders US\$ 10 will be added to cover the handling costs.

As soon as I receive your payment and registration form I will send you a temporary key that gives you 30 uncrippled starts. After 21 days you will receive your personal key. When you have got your personal key it is not possible to order your money back. This period is also needed for security reasons for payment through creditcard.

Ordering with creditcard

Credit card orders are handled by the Public software Library.

PsL is a service that handles credit card orders for shareware programmers. Of course, this is not a free service. This means that the costs of handling (US\$ 10) the order are added to the registration fee of US\$ 25. This means that the registering price via PsL will become US\$ 35.

Known Problems

<u>Support</u>

I don't know how to save my data.

You don't have to save your data yourself. When you insert a new record, close PMC or start another action, the changed to the current record are saved automaticly.

Some options like printing are disabled.

You need to <u>register</u> PMC to be able to use all features.

I made a database using an older version of PMC, but I can't open it with this version.

To solve some problems with the database the database has changed. Some extra fields have been added also. Don't worry Your old database can be converted with pmcconv.exe. It has been installed to thew same directory as PMC.

Open your old database and it will be converted immediately. After that you can exit or open another database to convert.

Use the button to start converting now.

I want to save my current settings but the menu option 'Save Settings' is disabled.

There can be two resons for this:

- You don't have a registered version of PMC
- The latest changes to your settings are already saved.

I get an error telling me there is not enough memory to start PMC's CD-player.

Some applications consume a lot of system resources.

Resident video drivers to change display settings installed for the Diamond Stealth video cards are an example of this.

Take a look at your system try (next to your clock) and shut down the applications your don't need. Insert a CD and press the Play button.

If there is enough memory free your CD will start to play now.

The Windows CD player starts up everytime I insert a new CD.

Windows Is configured to start the CD player as soon as a new Audio CD is inserted. You can turn it off with Tweak UI. Uncheck Play Audio CDs automaticly on the tab Paranoia. If you don't have Tweak UI you can download if for free at serveral major FTP sites and Mircosoft.

Press the button to start Tweak UI now.
