## Description

Win SetTime is a utility that dials any atomic clock in the world and automatically updates your computer clock and calendar EXACTLY. The program can determine the time via the atomic clocks at the U.S. Naval Observatory, National Institute for Standards & technology, and many others around the world.

Win SetTime was created by G. L. Liadis in 1992 with **Visual Basic**.

# Instalation

**Copy all Win SetTime files to a directory of your choice and create a new program group and run WSTIME.EXE.**

- 1) WSTIME.EXE
- 2) WSTREG.EXE
- 3) WSTTIME.HLP
- 4) MSCOMM.VBX    Place this file in your Windows\System directory.
- 5) FILE\_ID.DIZ
- 6) LICENSE.WRI

You also need Visual Basic Runtime (VBRUN300.DLL) available on CompuServe, America on-line, Microsoft Network and many other BBSs.

# Configuration

Win SetTime Configuration:

From the main window select settings, the settings dialog box will be displayed. This section is used to configure the Win SetTime program.

Select from the SERVICE CALL menu the clock you wish to call:

- 1) USNO, this is the default
- 2) NIST
- 3) ITALY
- 4) SWEDEN
- 5) AUSTRIA

You may also add any prefix or suffix to the phone number or enter another number.

## **YOUR TIME ZONE:**

Select the time zone in which you reside. Win SetTime gets the time from the atomic clocks in Greenwich Mean Time. Adjustments are then made to accurately reflect the correct time for your time zone.

## **USE DAYLIGHT SAVINGS TIME:**

If the time zone in which you reside is currently utilizing daylight savings time, check this box.

## **AUTO-TIME-OUT IF NOT CONNECTED:**

The value reflects the number of seconds Win SetTime will wait before disconnecting the call. The default is 90 seconds. You may change this value.

## **COMMUNICATION PORT:**

Select the COM port to which your modem is attached. Or you may click the AUTOMATIC PORT DETECTION button and Win SetTime will inform you of the available port.

## **DETECT SIGNAL:**

Select DIAL TONE if you want Win SetTime to detect if you have dial tone.  
Select BUSY if you want Win SetTime to detect if the clock you have dialed is busy.  
Or you may select NONE or BOTH.

## **DIALING METHOD:**

If your telephone service does not support tone dialing capabilities, select pulse.

## **MODEM INITIALIZATION:**

You can choose to either use Win SetTime default modem initialization string or use an alternate modem initialization string in the Modem Initialization section if your modem is incompatible with Win SetTime's

default initialization string. The default string works with 98% of the modems. If you have problems please select one of the following or Download WST45.ZIP for our BBS or Wide World Web home page:

**MODEMS SPEAKER MODE DURING THE CALL OPTIONS:**

- 1) Always off. If you do not wish to hear the modem during the call
- 2) Until Connected
- 3) Always On

When you are finished click on the OK button and your settings will be saved.

**SYNCHRONIZING YOUR PC's TIME/DATE:**

Once Win SetTime has been properly configured, synchronizing your computer's date and time is very simple.

Simply click on the DIAL button:

Once connected, your internal clock will then be synchronized to atomic precision. After the synchronization process is completed, Win SetTime will automatically terminate the call.

If at any time during the synchronization process you wish to abort, simply click on the HANG UP button.

After the synchronization is made, click on the **ACCEPT** button.
