We created this InfoRecord by first dragging the icon of the linked internet page from the Internet Browser onto the Infolist, then doing a 'select all' and copy on this page and pasting the clipboard content on this Infotext Area (you may also do this by drag & drop). Notice that much of the original formatting survives such a transfer. We finalized this short and ready procedure by assigning some adequate Categories to the new Info.

This should demonstrate how you may quickly store some relevant info that you find surfing the Web. Now, if you do not have the time at that instant and want to have another look later, consider to set an alarm on this Info that reminds you, say, two days later. Try it now: command 'New Alarm' in menu 'Info' or just press F12 (set the alarm 5 minutes from now).
