Carbon?

FreeSpace is a Carbon application. If you use MacOS X, it will run natively. If you use MacOS 8.6 or better, it will also work natively. You shouldn't worry about this.

Installation

FreeSpace is a very useful application for many people. Just drop an alias in the Apple Menu folder or on the Dock if you use MacOS X.

FreeSpace is a stand-alone application: it will work with any system, without any external file, on any computer. You don't have to read any documentation to understand how it works: just double-click on it, and enjoy!

Registration

FreeSpace is a freeware. That said, however, if you can't live without it, you can register it for \$9. The application looks simple because it is well-designed, but it wasn't easy to do it, so if you feel like it, you can support us for \$9.

automatically refresh the listing.

FreeSpace will work with *any* volume (Hard Disk, ZIP, CD-ROM), and will detect HFS, HFS+, ISO9660 and PC volumes. It will detect volumes from 720K to 99Gb. It will also detect a maximum of 12 volumes mounted on the desktop (other volumes will be skipped).
