## Reporting to generic databases.

When you are reporting from an unknown database (for example if you are writing a DbExport app), you can't use a fixed template, because the fields might change. For another demo of this feature see the DbDump app in the demo folder.

## Concepts shown

- ##Database##\* Use this directive to dump an entire database to the excel sheet.
- Rows are inserted as needed, but columns to the right will just be overwritten. (Do not write nothing to the right of ##Database##\*)
- You can use this for generic reporting, or also to dump a known database, and not writing
  all the field names. Also, it's a bit faster, but even so, I would not recommend this approach
  as a general one.
- Column captions are extracted from the DISPLAYTEXT property of the fields. If you are not
  creating a generic report, you can modify this property directly in the object inspector.
