This is a Report showing how to create a multiple master-detail report.

Concepts shown:

- Named Ranges: You have to define a named range for each dataset you want to use.
 FlexCel automatically finds ranges inside ranges and uses them to create master-details reports
- Conditional format: This is the way to format the data from a FlexCel Report. There is no
 way to change a cell format from FlexCel, to do it, just define a conditional format on that
 cell. While this is not as powerful as changing the formats from the code, it has the
 advantage that all the info remains inside the template, no additional code is needed.
- Groups. Those are that nice little (+) to the left of the report. Nothing special has to be done
 to use them, just define them in the template and they will propagate as needed. In this
 sample, I changed the "Options" of the group, so the (+) appears at the top and not the last
 cell of the group.
- Deleting empty rows. When FlexCel finds an empty dataset, it deletes all the range. You
 can see this at row 2790, customer Diver's Grotto.
