Features

- Will erase information stored in Windows about Internet sites visited!
- FREE and fully functional! Although donations are appreciated!
- Can Automatically run when computer boots, user logs in, or browsers are closed!
- Works with all 32-bit Windows, Internet Explorer, Netscape Navigator, & Opera!
- Erases the Cache, History, Cookies, Addresses, Messages, and Temporary Files!
- Now closes those annoying javascript browser popup windows!

Frequently Asked Questions

- Q: When I start Internet Sweeper it stops saying it needs VB40032.DLL or Error # 0.
- A: Some download sites do not accept the runtime libraries in the ZIP file.
- Please download the version WITH RUNTIME from http://www.geocities.com/Internet_Sweeper To reduce download times, some versions do not contain vb40032.dll.
- Q: Why is there a nagging message?
- A: Because Internet Sweeper is a nagware program. If you make a donation I'll send a version that won't nag you. :) Make donations to brettemery@attbi.com at http://www.paypal.com
- Q: Why are some files not deleted?

A: Files that are in use cannot be deleted while Windows is running. Check the **Delete files that are in use when Windows restarts** option to remove these files upon Windows startup.

- A: For safety, Internet Sweeper will only delete Netscape's cache files when located in a "Cache" subfolder. (e.g. Files in C:\temp\Cache would be deleted, C:\Cache\Files would not) Also files in root or Windows directories are not deleted in case they are accidentally set as temporary directories.
- A: Internet Explorer 5 uses the C:\Windows\Temporary Internet Files\Content.IE5 folder to store files. The files in C:\Windows\Temporary Internet\Files could be from a previous version of Internet Explorer.
- A: Netscape Navigator may need to be reinstalled. You may be running a version that was not properly installed so Internet Sweeper cannot properly find it.
- Q: What is the Popup Control ?
- A: It monitors both Internet Explorer and Netscape Navigator windows and closes ones you didn't open! Every half second, the popup control scans for new browser windows.

When no browsers are running, this interval is automatically set at 5 seconds to reduce system load.

If new windows are detected since the previous scan, and the SHIFT or CTRL key is not held down, then those new windows are closed.

Press the CTRL key or SHIFT before clicking a new link to override (allows new windows to remain open).

However the SHIFT key while clicking a link is the Save As command in Netscape Navigator.

The Popup Control can also sweep when all browsers are closed.

You can quickly enable or disable the popup control by right clicking on the system tray icon.

Internet Sweeper – Settings for Microsoft Windows

Recent Documents: Check to clear the Recently Accessed Documents.

Passwords: Check to delete the Password Lists. Use this feature with the 'Show Prompts' option checked at least once to ensure correct operation.

Temp Directory: Check to delete files in the Temp directory.

Find Computers: Check to clear the Find Computer Names recent list.

Find Documents: Check to clear the Find Documents and Search Assistants.

Recycle Bin: Check to empty the recycle bin on all drives.

Internet Sweeper – Settings for Internet Explorer

Cache: Check to delete Temporary Internet Files. This includes the index.dat files. You must have the 'Delete files that are in use when Windows restart' option checked in order to delete index.dat files!

Cookies: Check to delete all Cookies saved with Internet Explorer.

History: Check to clear the sites visited in Internet Explorer.

Address: Check to clear the URL's you've typed in Internet Explorer.

Passwords: Check to clear the usernames and passwords saved in the Intelliforms

AutoComplete: Check to clear the saved forms in Internet Explorer. Use this feature with the 'Show Prompts' option checked at least once to ensure correct operation.

Internet Sweeper – Settings for Netscape Navigator

Cache: Check to delete files in the cache for all users. Cookies: Check to delete the cookies file. History: Check to remove visited URL entries.

Newsgroups: Check to remove all the newsgroup information.

Opera

Cache: Check to delete files in Opera's Cache directories. Cookies: Check to delete cookies file in Opera. Windows: Check to delete the saved windows in Opera. Addresses: Check to delete addresses typed in Opera.

Internet Sweeper - Popup Control

Close Popups: Check to enable automatic closing of those annoying javascript windows.

Sweep Automatically: Check to sweep when all browsers and closed and when exited.

Press the CTRL key before clicking a new link to override (allows new windows to remain open).

Holding down the the SHIFT key also works but it's the Save As command when clicking on a hyperlink in Netscape Navigator and the Full Screen command in Internet Explorer.

Internet Sweeper - Settings

Run Automatically at Windows Startup / User Login: Check to run Internet Sweeper when Windows starts up or another user logs in. You must enable this option for the popup control and other startup options to work properly.

Run Scan Disk or Norton Disk Doctor at Startup: Scan hard drive for errors when bad shutdown detected. Upon startup of Internet Sweeper will tell Windows to force a scandisk next boot. Internet Sweeper restores the original settings when closed. Thereby if the computer crashes before Internet Sweeper closes properly, a scandisk (or Norton Disk Doctor if installed) will be run.

Include Read-Only files: Clears the read-only flag before attempting to delete a file

Wipe (not just delete): Overwrite files with random data to prevent viewing after deletion.

Delete files that are in use when Windows Restarts: Have Windows remove all the files that could not be deleted during sweeping upon computer startup. You must have this option checked in order to delete index.dat files!

Prompts to Minimize on Exit & Reboot after Sweep: Displays a message box when Internet Sweeper is exited or requires a reboot after Sweeping to remove files that were in use. Uncheck if you are familiar with Internet Sweeper and do not wish to be informed. Unchecking will Minimize on Exit and not Reboot after Sweep.

System Tray Icon: Show Internet Sweeper icon and right-click menu in System Tray if checked.

Taskbar Icon: Show Internet Sweeper icon in the Taskbar when checked while minimized.

If the System Tray Icon and Taskbar icon options are both unchecked, Internet Sweeper will become invisible when minimized. Hold down the **ALT**, **SHIFT**, & **Z** keys simultaneously for a few seconds to restore Internet Sweeper when hidden.

Log: Show log window for Internet Sweeper activity and windows monitored.

Sweep

Click to clear all the selected options now!

About

Show information about Internet Sweeper and view this help file.

Uninstall

Click this button to remove Internet Sweeper from your computer.

Close

Exits Internet Sweeper. You will be prompted to minimize if either the Close Popups or Scan Disk options are checked and the Prompts to Minimize option is checked.

Minimize

Runs Internet Sweeper in the background. An icon may appear in the Task Bar or System Tray based on <u>Settings</u>. Hold down the ALT, SHIFT, & Z key for a few seconds to restore Internet Sweeper when hidden.

Close Popups

Check to automatically close new browser windows. Press the CTRL key or SHIFT before clicking a new link to override (allows new windows to remain open).

Sweep Automatically

Check to automatically Sweep when all browsers are closed and when Internet Sweeper is exited.

Run Automatically

Check to run Internet Sweeper when Windows starts up or another user logs in. You must enable this option for the \underline{Popup} <u>Control</u> and other startup options to work properly.

Run Scan Disk

Scan hard drive for errors when bad shutdown detected.

Include Read-Only files

Uncheck to skip deleting files with the Read-Only attribute set.

Wipe (not just delete)

Overwrite files with random data before deleting to prevent viewing after deletion.

System Tray Icon

Show an Internet Sweeper icon with a right-click menu in System Tray if checked.

Taskbar Icon

Show Internet Sweeper icon in the Taskbar when checked while minimized, if the System Tray icon option is unchecked.

Delete files that are in use when Windows restarts

Tell Windows to remove the files that could not be deleted during Sweeping upon computer startup. You should have this option checked in order to delete index.dat files!

Show Prompts and Help

Novice users leave this box checked. Advanced users of Internet Sweeper uncheck this box to prevent information and error messages, along with popup help, from showing.

Log Activity

Show log window for Internet Sweeper activity and windows monitored. This is used for debugging only and should remain unchecked for normal operation.

Cache

Check this option to erase the cache files.

Cache

Checking this option erases the Temporary Internet Files and index.dat files when sweeping.

Cookies

Check this option to erase the cookies.

Addresses

Check to erase the addresses or URLs you have typed in.

Newsgroups

Check to remove all the newsgroups saved in Netscape.

Windows

Check to delete the saved windows in Opera.

AutoComplete

Check to delete the AutoComplete / Intelliforms saved in Internet Explorer. This includes the usernames and passwords in forms but not those saved as $\underline{network \ login \ passwords}$.

History

Check to clear the history of sites (url's) visited.

Recent Documents

Check to clear the Recently Accessed Documents.

Temp Directory

Check to delete files in the Windows\Temp directory.

Find Computers

Check to clear the Find Computer Names recent list.

Passwords

Check to delete the Passwords saved on Internet Explorer AutoComplete / Intelliforms. Check the AutoComplete option to also remove Usernames.

Find Documents

Check to clear the Find Documents and Search Assistants.

Password Lists

Check to delete the Windows Password Lists (*.pwl files). This includes your **network login passwords** and websites that use basic authentication.

Help

Click this button to view the help file.

America Online

Erases AOL information, including websites you've visited. AOL uses Internet Explorer as it's web browser. Therefore clear AOL's cache and cookies using the Internet Explorer options.

Compatibility

Click this option to disable the Windows Internet Extensions, which may cause Internet Sweeper to crash on XP.

Disk Cleanup

Check to run the Microsoft Disk Cleanup utility. When first checked, the Disk Cleanup settings window appears allowing you select which options Disk Cleanup will erase when the <u>Sweep button</u> is clicked.
