Screen Query is a utility which will assist you in determining whether your LCD screen / CRT monitor contains any dead pixels. Although a certain percentage of dead pixels is considered "normal", there's always a chance you have a 100% pristine display!

### :: New Features

- **Multiple Monitor Support**

Screen Query now handles multiple monitors (mirrored or spanning mode).

- **Code Rewrite**

Rewritten from scratch for Mac OS X, v2.0 contains dramatic speed improvements.

### :: Usage

Launch the application, follow on-screen instructions. Upon starting the test, look for any miscolored dots on the screen. This usually indicates the pixel is defective or stuck. If this happens, try "massaging" the pixel lightly with the tip of your finger. This may bring it back to life. Otherwise, if the pattern appears solid with no apparent dots, your monitor is in pristine order.
