

# Bluetooth To Internet Utility

## What is Bluetooth To Internet Utility?

Bluetooth To Internet Utility is a small application that enables you to share a Mac's internet connection, over Bluetooth, to other Macs and Palm devices that are within range.

## What do the start-up scripts do?

The start-up scripts do the same as the application, i.e. they start a PPP server, but you still have to enter the Domain Name Server address. I hope to make this automatic in a forthcoming release. Most ISP's use static DNS addresses, but if yours is dynamic, use the scripts that show a dialog at start-up. Use either the Palm scripts to connect a Palm device to the internet, or the Mac scripts to connect another Mac to the internet.

## How do I make a script run at start-up time?

Open System Preferences (In the Apple Menu) then click on Accounts. Click on your name then the Startup Items tab. Click the + button, and navigate to where the script you want is. The script must be copied onto your hard disk to work when you startup your Mac, it won't work from the disk image.

## What will be in the next release?

The next release should have the following extra features, although they are likely to change:

- Automatic enabling of File Sharing
- Mac to Palm support for different connection types
- Symbian OS sharing support, i.e. Nokia N-Gage, 3650

If I include Symbian OS support, I will probably make a new GUI.
