New features and improved functionality

Enhanced MPEG.Now™ encoding New version of the MPEG.Now™ codec makes both DV-to-MPEG capture and file transcoding faster than ever.



LPCM audio support Offers uncompressed linear pulse code modulation (LPCM) available in many home DVD players. LPCM produces high-quality sound similar to DVD-Audio.

Multiple video titles formats with intelligent file conversion on the same disc

- To enable this function, simply select **Do not convert compliant file** in the **Make Disc** dialog box under the **Finish Step**.
- Gives you the flexibility to store videos and audios in various formats, aspect ratios, and bit rates on the same disc (for example, the combination of MPEG-1, MPEG-2, LPCM and AC-3).
- To save time, files already compliant to the output file formats are not re-rendered while burning a disc.

Instant disc burning Creates a DVD directly from existing VIDEO_TS folder without generating a temporary disc image file. This means less time in disc burning and less hard disk space required.

Notes:

- If you still want to create the disc image file, select **Create disc image file** in the **Make Disc** dialog box.
- Instant disc burning is available for a non-CSS (Content Scrambling System, a copy protection mechanism) DVD only.

Better Ulead PhotoImpact UFO file support You can add creative and re-editable UFO objects to DVD menus.

DVD+R compliant Adds this format to the existing support for DVD+RW and DVD-R/RW to provide the widest in compatibility.

Smart DVD/VCD file size detection If the total file size for video projects exceeds DVD's normal 4 GB capacity or VCD's normal 580 MB capacity, Ulead DVD Workshop automatically detects it. A message also appears to let you decide whether to continue the burning process.

Ease-to-use time counter Lets you monitor remaining time while compiling, burning or erasing discs.

Audio and video playback synchronization On the disc you burn using DVD Workshop, videos with its associated audio tracks are played back synchronously.

Handy debugging information Displays useful message about how to correct menus and buttons whenever errors occur.

Other improvements:

- Advanced quality of the video motion button.
- A wider support for capture devices.
