INSTALLATION:

Please create a new directory (ie. \QRP) and copy all four files into it.

If the program will not load into memory, the likely culprit maybe the dll, BWCC.DLL. This DLL is the control graphics library and may already exist on your harddisk. It is important to use the version shipped with QRP HomeBuilder and problems may arise if another

version of this DLL is in your path.

If another version exists, it may be in your \Windows\System directory or perhaps in your \Windows directory.

In general, as long as the EXE and DLL are in the same directory, there should be no problems.
