Whats New?

Version 1.30

- New inverted cross cursor. Now could be seen easily on any background.
- Fixed a bug which destroys the captured bitmap when copied twice.
- Changed a few internal dialog messages.

Version 1.20

- Now works with one or two button mouse. Though three would be nifty.
- Implementation of a pop-up menu system to assist users with one or two button mouse.
- Capturer's background color now conforms to the Windows application background color. The color may be set in the Control Panel.
- Fixed the links in the on-line help file.

Version 1.10

- First implementation with on-line help.
- New better looking icon.

Version 1.00

- Original version of Capturer.
- Somewhat object-oriented.
- Capture any area on the screen and able to copy to the Windows clipboard.
- This version requires a three button mouse.

Overview

Cyno Screen Capturer is a screen capturing utility for Windows 3.1. In a way, it is object-oriented. All operations are done with a three button mouse, or with a pop-up menu if only a one or two button mouse is available.

Capturer is able to capture any part of the Windows screen and place it in Windows clipboard on your command. You may then transfer the image to another application. It does not automatically copy the image to clipboard so you may use it as a separate clipboard or other purposes

Menus

Pop-Up Menu

The pop-up menu is accessible with the left button of the mouse. Simply double click in the client area of the Capturers window.

Mark - Command to start in mark mode. For mouse without a right button.

Copy - Copy the image to clipboard. For mouse without a middle button.

Help - Show this help file.

Usage - A dialog box showing the operations for a three button mouse.

About - Shows some general information about this program.

System Menu

The system menu include three entries added by Capturer. They are Help, Usage, and About. Just as they imply, Help shows this help file, Usage shows a dialog with all the operations, and About shows the About dialog.

Usage

Originally, the Capturer is designed for a three button mouse with the concept of object-oriented operations. A menu was not even implemented at first. However, for the benefit of the users with one or two button mouse, the Capturer is now improved to include a pop-up menu for users without a three button mouse.

Three button operations is still available and probably much easy to access than the menu. The concept of object-oriented operations will continue to improve along with three button operations.

Three Button Mouse

Left Button - Marks area to capture.

Middle Button - Copies bitmap to clipboard.

Right Button- Begin Marking.

Left Button Double-Click - Access the menu.

The last three operations above require the click(s) to be in the client area of the Capturers window.

Two Button Mouse

The operation of a two button mouse is the same as the three button mouse above, except without the middle button. Instead, the operation is available in the pop-up menu.

One Button Mouse

The operation of a one button mouse is the same as a two or three button mouse, except operations requiring the middle or the right button are only available through the pop-up menu.
