SYSTEM REQUIREMENTS

FolkFinder: Assistant for Windows is designed to run on an IBM PC or 100%-PC compatible computer using a 286, 386, or 486 processor and running Microsoft Windows 3.x in standard or enhanced mode. One floppy-disk drive (5.25-inch drive with 1.2 MB capacity or 3.5-inch drive with 720KB capacity) and a hard drive.

FolkFinder: Assistant for Windows requires 724K of available disk space if you already have vbrun300.dll installed. If you do not have vbrun300.dll installed, an additional 399KB of disk space will be required.

- 1. PKUNZIP E FFADEMO Extracts all files (already done)
- 2. Read this README.WRI (or README.TXT) file
- 3. Select RUN from the File menu of the Program Manager or File Manager.
- 4. Type
 - D:\DIRECTORY\setup
 - where D and DIRECTORY are the target drive and directory where you unzipped FFADEMO.
- 5. Follow the setup instrunctions on the screen.

You are now ready to begin using FolkFinder: Assistant for Windows.

Starting FolkFinder: Assistant

FolkFinder: Assistant is started by double clicking the FolkFinder: Assistant icon in the FolkFinder: Assistant Group. This will start FolkFinder: Assistant.

- 4. All conversion tables are shown, but only angular, standard area, standard lengths and distances, and metric conversions are fully functional.
- 5. SOUNDEX codes are generated for Smith only.
