

RUN HELP

To add or edit an icon on the menu simply point the mouse pointer to the position you want and hit the right mouse button. The edit screen will have several fields that you should fill in:

- **Description** = short description to display as you drag the pointer over the icon.
- **Working drive** = single letter for drive (blank = default drive)
- **Command** = the command to execute when chosen (can browse)
- **Icon** = what icon to display on the menu bar (can browse)
- **Working dir.** = directory to use as working directory

The shareware version is limited to 15 icons on each menu bar. The registered version will hold 30.
