

OMNICON 1.0



OmniCon 1.0 is a Windows based application that has been written using Microsoft Visual Basic 3.0. **OmniCon 1.0** is designed to perform conversions between various units within various physical quantities. For example, if you wanted to know how many feet there were in a metre, or how many ounces there were in a litre, then **OmniCon 1.0** would be THE tool to use!

Only three files are needed to run **OmniCon 1.0**:

- 1) The main executable file - OMNICON10.EXE
- 2) The Windows help file - OMNICON10.HLP
- 3) The Visual Basic runtime library - VBRUN300.DLL
(available on most BBS's and on virtually EVERY internet FTP site dealing with Microsoft Windows applications!)

The last file is not included with the OMNICON10.ZIP file that you downloaded, but as mentioned, can be obtained almost anywhere. (Just post a message asking where it is, and someone will tell you!)

To install OmniCon v1.0 on your system:

- 1) Make a directory on your hard drive called "omnicn10" and put the two files "omnicn10.exe" and "omnicn10.hlp" into it (as well as the readme files).
- 2) Make sure that you have the Visual Basic runtime library (VBRUN300.DLL) in your WINDOWS/SYSTEM directory.
- 3) Go into Program Manager, click on File/New, and choose "Program Item". In the boxes, enter "OmniCon 1.0" for the description, and type the directory name PLUS "omnicn10.exe" in the Command Line box. (eg. "c:\omnicn10\omnicn10.exe")
- 4) Click "OK" and you will have set up an icon. You can start OmniCon by double-clicking on this icon, or by double - clicking "omnicn10.exe" in File Manager.

OmniCon 1.0 is distributed as SHAREWARE. This means that you can use this program for thirty (30) days without paying for it, but if you decide to keep it after 30 days, you must register it by sending \$10 (CDN or US funds) to the following address:
