#### **General Information**

The Calculator provides the functionality and feel of a standard desktop calculator and provides a useful Windows calculator. In particular, many calculators have had such problems as: rounding errors, only 12 to 14 significant digits, poor or no access to historical entries, no print capabilities and designs that did not meet the needs of common users.

Using the Calculator, you can: perform general mathematics, maintain an audit trail, copy selected entries to the clipboard, print the calculator tape, and control the calculator by mouse or keyboard.

Basic Features of the Calculator include the following:

- 1. <u>Copy</u> Copies selected entries to the Windows Clipboard for pasting into other applications.
- 2. Print Prints the entry list (Audit trail or historical tape)
- 3. Percent Percentages calculations such as, sale plus sales tax.
- 4. Memory Store, sum and recall calculation results.
- 5. 21 digits 18 significant digits and up to 19 decimal places.
- 6. Accuracy Extended floating point calculations yield no rounding errors,.
- 7. Design Uses the latest controls and provides ergonomic and aesthetic look and feel.

### **Getting Started**

To activate the calculator, simply select the **Calculator** menu item or the Calculator speed-menu button.

To Exit from the Calculator invoke the popup menu by clicking the right mouse button or type Alt-F, and select **Exit** (or double click on the '-' sign in the upper left hand corner to activate the system menu and select **Close**).

### Menu

To activate the Menu, place the cursor inside the calculator window and click the right mouse button or type the **Alt-F** key combination.

## Copy

To copy calculator results to the clipboard, select the data to be copied from the tape list and from the menu select **File**, **Copy**. Selected data can also be copied using the **Ctrl-C** key combination.

## **Print**

To  ${\bf Print}$  calculator results: from the Menu, select  ${\bf File}, {\bf Print}$  or use  ${\bf Ctrl-P}$  key combination.

## **Printer Setup**

To invoke the Printer Setup dialog: from the Menu, select  ${\bf File}$ ,  ${\bf Printer}$   ${\bf Setup}$  or use  ${\bf Ctrl-S}$  key combination.

## **Exit**

To exit the calculator from the Menu select **Exit** or use **Alt-F4** key combination..
