The Administrator Setup for Novell* IntranetWare* Client* for Windows** NT** installs the following Novell IntranetWare Client for Windows NT administrative utilities:

- NetWare Administrator* NT
- Novell Workstation Manager

Insert Disk

ADMSETUP.EXE requires the specified disk. Insert the disk in the disk drive, then continue.

Installation Complete

All files selected have been copied and all application objects created.

The administrator now has to associate application objects with appropriate users. Application objects are associated using NWAdmin. Choose **Run NWAdmnNT** to run NWADMNNT.EXE. From within NWAdmnNT, select the appropriate users, groups, or containers and associate the newly created application objects.

Installing Administrative Utilities

The administration utilities require approximately 20 MB of hard disk space.

Note: To install the administration utilities, the following conditions must be met:

- 1. You must have admin rights on the server and in the container or tree where you are installing the administrative utilities.
- 2. The tree that contains the server where you want to install the utilities must be set as your <u>current tree</u> before you run ADMSETUP.EXE.

To install the administration utilities

- 1. Locate the ADMSETUP.EXE icon in the I386 directory of the Novell IntranetWare Client for Windows NT CD.
- 2. Double-click ADMSETUP.EXE.
- 3. Choose Yes to accept the Novell Terms and Conditions.

If you choose No, you will not be able to install the administration utilities.

- 4. Choose **Continue** after reading the Administrator Utility title screen. If you choose **Cancel**, you will not be able to complete the installation.
- 5. <u>Choose</u> the utilities you want to install by checking the check box next to the utility's name. There are two choices:
- NetWare Administrator
- Novell Workstation Manager
- 6. Choose a server from the **To Server** list.

You must have sufficient rights to write files to the server. You should choose a server that you have Administrator rights to.

7. Choose OK.

8. Choose Run NW Admin to start NetWare Administrator.

OR

Choose **Close** to exit the installer without starting NetWare Administrator.

This program will add NDS Application objects to your NDS tree. In order to add these objects, your NDS schema needs to be extended. The administrator tools installation for IntranetWare Client for Windows NT detected that your NDS Schema has not been extended for these application objects.

Choose Yes to modify the tree so that Application objects can be created.

Choose **No** if you don't want to modify the tree. If you choose **No**, application objects for the products you just installed will not be created.

Overwrite File

A file is about to be overwritten with an older version of the same name. This can occur when different versions of the same file exist and get installed in an incorrect order.

Choose **Yes** to overwrite the newer file this once.

Choose **Yes to All** to always overwrite newer files with older files. You will not be prompted to overwrite again. Choose **No** to not overwrite this file with and older version this once.

Choose **No to All** to never overwrite newer files with older files. You will not be prompted to overwrite again. Choose **Cancel** to exit setup.

To set or change the current tree

Follow the instructions for your version of Windows NT, below.

Windows NT 3.51

- 1. From the Main group, choose **Control Panel**.
- 2. Choose IntranetWare.
- 3. From the **Current Attachments** list, choose the server on the tree where you want to install the administrative utilities.
- 4. Choose Set Primary.

Windows NT 4.0

- 1. Right-click Network Neighborhood.
- 2. Choose IntranetWare Connections.
- 3. Choose the tree that contains the server where you want to install the administrative utilities.
- 4. Choose Set Current.

- 1. Choose one or more products to copy to the server selected
- 2. Choose a server to copy product files to
- 3. Choose **OK** to begin installation.
