Installation Instructions

To install NDS* for NT, you need to run two programs:

NDSSETUP.EXE

.

ADMSETUP.EXE.

Run NDSSETUP.EXE

- 1. From the Windows** NT** server, run NDSSETUP.EXE.
- 2. Follow the on-screen instructions.
- 3. When prompted, reboot your machine.
- 4. After you reboot, the Domain Object Wizard launches automatically.
- 5. Follow the on-screen instructions. If you need additional information while using the Domain Object Wizard, click the **Help** button.

Run ADMSETUP.EXE

Prerequisites

.

- You must have Administrator rights on the IntranetWare* server and in the container or tree where you are installing the administration utilities.
- .

The Directory tree that contains the server where you want to install the utilities must be set as your current tree before you run ADMSETUP.EXE.

Procedures

- 1. From the Windows NT workstation, run ADMSETUP.EXE.
- 2. Choose **Yes** to accept the Novell Terms and Conditions. If you choose **No**, you will not be able to install the administration utilities.
- 3. Choose **Continue** after reading the Administrator Utility title screen. If you choose **Cancel**, you will not be able to complete the installation.
- 4. Choose the utilities you want to install by checking the check box next to the utility's name. There are two choices: **NetWare* Administrator** and **Novell* Workstation Manager**.
- 5. Choose a server from the **To Server** list. You must have sufficient rights to write files to the server. You should choose a server that you have Administrator rights to.
- 7. Choose **OK**. A progress screen with two progress bars appears. The top bar shows which application is being installed. The bottom bar shows the percentage of files that have been installed. When the files are installed, the Installation Complete dialog box appears.
- 8. Choose **Run NW Admin** to start NetWare Administrator or choose **Close** to exit the installer without starting NetWare Administrator.

Launch the Domain Object Wizard that will create the Domain object(s) for your NDS Directory tree
