## **MSMQ Address Help**

## Display name

Full name of the destination queue. This name is for display purposes only.

## Oueue label

Label of the destination queue, as defined in MSMQ. The label is used by the connector to locate the destination queue and deliver messages to it.

Some queues collect data for several users. An example of such a queue is the inbound queue of the MSMQ Exchange connector. This queue collects E-mail for many Exchange users. In order to send to a user in such a queue, precede the queue label with the user's name, followed by the '@' sign (i.e. user@queue)

## Send Exchange rich-text format

The MSMQ connector usually sends mail in plain text format. However, if the recipient is another Exchange/MAPI user, it is best to send the Exchange rich-text format of the mail to him.

Check this box only if you know the destination recipient is an Exchange/MAPI user.
