Introduction:

Welcome to Slash99, a file manager. This is what I think Microsoft was talking about when they were touting the new "integrated" explorer that was supposed to be included with Windows98. What happened to theirs? :).

Basically this is an explorer on steroids. Click on a file, and if Slash recognizes the filetype it will automatically open it in the bottom pane. It's that simple. You can now throw away: Winzip, Paint Shop Pro, Office97, etc. :). Just kidding, I would probably hold on to them, as this will never reach the full potential of all those apps - and it's still beta.

Slash 1.00 is freeware:

It will never disable, and no features are crippled. Sorry I don't have more documentation yet, the next version will have a lot more. I spent 99% of my time on the program this time round. I think it is fairly easy to figure out though, and there really isn't any damage you can do by just playing around with it.

One exception!: The delete button will delete files (only – directories next version) without any confirmation at all. It doesn't go to the recycle bin and there is no way to undo it unless you have a separate disk utility to unerase it. I think you will be impressed at how much faster files get deleted this way though. Pressing the delete key will use Windows95 to delete the file as it normally does.

Future versions, however, will either be ad-supported or shareware. A **LOT** of work has gone into Slash, and I can't work on it forever for free. Version 1.00 will always be available as freeware; so if you can't stand ads, and don't want to register Slash, you can still use this version.

Text Files (no larger than 64k this version)

Graphics (jpeg, bitmap, gifs next version)
Zip files
Rich Text Format
AVI's (Uncompressed this version)
HTML (MSIE 3+ Required)
