2 installation and uninstallation

2.1 system requirements

hardware: PC (pentium II 300 MHz) with at least 128 MB RAM, SVGA graphics board with at least 65000 colors, 5MB free hard-disk space

operating system: microsoft windows 2000, XP with latest service packs

2.2 installation

the installer (karsten-setup.exe) copies the karsten program files to a program folder of your choice. it can also update a previous installation.

some program libraries that are shared with other programs are copied to the system folder. these files are:

rtl100bpl, vcl100.bpl, vclx100.bpl, vcljpg100.bpl, lpng.dll

2.3 uninstallation

use the "add/remove" programs control applet to uninstall karsten.

3 about documentation

karsten slide show has been translated to english only recently. while the program is now available in english, the online help is still german only. furthermore, that help file covers version 3.0.0 of the program. in the meantime many new features have been added but the help file hasn't been updated. karsten

should be pretty easy to use, though. for a list of the main features please refer to the project web site at http://karsten.sourceforge.net.
