The following terms govern your use of the enclosed Software unless you have a separate written agreement with HP.

License Grant

HP grants you a license to use one copy of the version of this Software on any one hardware product. "You" means the company, entity or individual whose funds are used to pay the license fee. "Use" means storing, loading, installing, executing or displaying the Software. You may not modify the Software or disable any licensing or control features of the Software except as an intended part of the Software's programming features. If the Software is authorized for "concurrent use", only that number of users allowed under your network license controls (identified in your documentation) may use the Software concurrently.

Ownership

The Software is owned and copyrighted by HP or its third party suppliers. Your license confers no title or ownership in the Software and should not be construed as a sale of any right in the Software. HP's third party suppliers may protect their rights in the event of any violation of these terms.

Copies and Adaptations

You may only make copies or adaptations of the Software for archival purposes or when copying or adaptation is an essential step in the authorized use of the Software. You must reproduce all copyright notices in the original Software on all authorized copies or adaptations. You may not copy the Software onto any bulletin board or similar system.

No Disassembly or Decryption

You may not disassemble, decompile or decrypt the Software unless HP's prior written consent is obtained. In some jurisdictions, HP's consent may not be required for disassembly or decompilation. Upon request, you will provide HP with reasonably

detailed information regarding any disassembly or decompilation.

Transfer

Your license will automatically terminate upon any transfer of the Software. Termination

HP may terminate your license upon notice for failure to comply with any of these Terms. Upon termination, you must immediately destroy the Software together with all copies, adaptations and merged portions in any form.
