Custom Installation

A custom installation will install only the selected components into a user-selectable directory.

When the program is installed, an extra menu (**Easy-CD**) appears in File Manager, containing the commands which allow you to record selected files/directories to compact disc.

Magic Lantern

Magic Lantern is the most powerful and versatile Photo CD viewer on the market. It allows you to: view, display, convert, process, and export Photo CD images in five resolutions; select and display multiple images; rotate, flip, and crop them (cropped images can be viewed and exported at any resolution, including poster); export images as TIFF, RIFF, PCX, or Encapsulated PostScript, or copy to the Windows clipboard; create slideshows of any or all images on disc, in a specific order or randomly shuffled.

Numbered Error Messages

The following errors could occur during setup.

Error Number	Error Message
101	Setup is unable to find a hard disk location to store temporary files. Make at least 500Kb of free disk space available and then try the installation again.
104, 105, 106	Setup is unable to run an intermediate file needed to proceed with the installation.
107	Setup is unable to locate the script file SETUP.INS which is needed to complete the installation.
110	Setup was started with a command line argument that contained an incomplete parameter.
201	Setup is unable to initialize the installation program. Setup was internally unable to create a main window or create internal window classes, perhaps due to a low memory condition.
202	Setup is unable to initialize the installation program. Setup was unable to load the script file due to low memory conditions.
420	Setup is unable to copy the installation support file "filename" to a temporary location.
421	Setup is unable to copy the installation support file ~INS0762.LIB to a temporary location. Make more space available and try again.
422	Setup is unable to expand the installation support file filename.
423	Setup is unable to load the installation script file.
424	Setup has encountered an internal stack overflow error. Close all applications, restart the system and try the installation again.
425	Setup has encountered an incomplete return statement in the script. Check your script for unmatched return statements.
502	Setup is unable to initialize the installation program. The script file may be bad.
701	A division by zero error was detected in the script. Installation will continue.
702	An internal error has occurred. Insufficient memory to allocate buffer.
703	An internal read error has occurred on filename. Unable to load installation instructions.
704	Filename file has become corrupted. Unable to load installation instructions.
> 3000	Error messages ranging from 3000 to 3021 are internal memory-related error conditions.

Other Error Messages

The following errors have been encountered during testing.

IS20INST - An error has occurred in your application.

This error can have several possible causes. If you get this error, remove any other programs that may be running. Change your display resolution to standard VGA and restart Windows. The major causes of this error include screen savers, anti-virus programs, and display drivers. Running Setup again on a "bare-bones" system should work.

~MP files left behind in TEMP directory.

If the installation fails before completion, temporary files may be left behind. These files should be in the directory pointed to by the environment variable TEMP. These files are named **~INS0?63 ~MP**, and should be deleted before attempting to install.

For any other error message, try the following:

Insure that the TEMP environment variable points to a drive with at least 5 megabytes of free space.

Remove all running programs, including screen savers and anti-virus programs.

Reset the display resolution to standard VGA.
