

## Zoom>About (Plug-In TSZOOM1)

This plug-in can only be used if you have purchased a personal unlock code. You can order the unlock code for this plug-in directly from TommySoftware®. For further information see [Order & Unlock](#).

### Information

This plug-in enables you to store and manage zoom areas. To activate the plug-in, choose the command **Configuration>Zoom>Zoom Areas**. A popup window is displayed. The button "pin" in the top left hand corner enables you to keep the window permanently on the screen when the button is pressed.

To save a zoom area, choose any one comand from the program (e.g. [Configuration>Zoom>Section](#)) and set the desired area and zoom factor. Click on the third icon on the left side (the blue arrow down) to save the current zoom area. You are then asked to enter a name for the zoom area. This can be any name with the exception of a star (\*) at the beginning. Up to one hundred entries can be stored.

To activate a saved zoom area, you simply double click on a zoom area name or select the name and click on the second icon on the left (a yellow arrow). The saved zoom area will immediately be activated. If the button "pin" was not set, the zoom area window disappears again and has to be opened again next time you need it.

An entry for a saved zoom area can be deleted by selecting the entry and clicking on the fourth icon from the left (a green cross). You can only delete entries without a star (\*) at the beginning.

You can rename an entry with the fifth icon (a purple edit mark with an arrow). Select the entry you want to rename and click on the button. A dialog box appears and you can enter the new name for the zoom area. You cannot rename entries that already have a star (\*) at the beginning and you cannot enter a new name that begins with a star.



The zoom areas created with the zoom plug-in are loaded and saved together with the current drawing, if the "Plug-In Settings" option of the file options (see [Configuration>Options>File Options](#)) is set (it is set by default).
