- 1. To convert a Word-94 (6.x) version of Act.dot to Word-97 (8.x), follow these steps:
- 2. Open the Word-95 macro with Word-97.
 - 2.1. Open .../Word/Master/6/act.dot with Word-97.
 - 2.2. When you get a warning about macros being unsafe, select "Enable Macros".
 - 2.3. Select OK when VisualBasic tells you that some features of the macro are incompatible with Word-97
 - 2.4. Now that Word-97 has opened act.dot, select "Tools->Macro->Visual Basic Editor".
- 3. Fix compile incompatibilities.
 - 3.1. In VisualBasic select "Debug->Compile TemplateProject".
 - 3.2. At the first error, look at the top of file and remove the "rem" from the function causing the error.
 - 3.3. Select "Debug->Compile TemplateProject" again.
 - 4.4. At the next error, look at the top of the file and remove the "rem" from the three function declarations
 - 3.5. Select "Debug->Compile TemplateProject" again. There should be no errors.
 - 3.6. Macro conversion is now complete.
 - 3.7. In VisualBasic, select "File->Return to Word".
 - 3.8. Select "File->Save As..." and save the document as .../Word/Master/8/act.dot.
- 4. Fix problems with WordBasic legacy object.
 - 4.1. From Visual Basic, select "Edit->Replace".
 - 4.2. Select "Current Project" from the "Search" group box.
 - 4.3. Enter the three characters: "Single Quote-Tilde-Single Quote" in the Find text box.
 - 4.4. Clear anything out of the Replace text box. (Should be like this already)
 - 4.5 Select "Replace All".
- 5. Clean up after Word-97's failed conversion of customized menus.
 - 5.1. In Word-97, select "Tools->Customize...".
 - 5.2. Select the "ToolBars" tab from the "Customize" modeless dialog box.
 - 5.3. Select each of the checked tool bars and click on "Reset".
 - 5.4. Select "OK"
- 6. Customize the menus for ACT!
 - 6.1. Select the "Commands" tab.
 - 6.2. Select "Macros" from the "Categories" drop-down list.
 - 6.3. Select the "File" menu which will drop it down for customizing.
 - 6.4. Drag the "SendEmailUsingAct" macro to the bottom of the "File" menu.
 - 6.5. Right click on the new menu item that you just created to bring up its properties.
 - 6.6. Select "Begin New Group".
 - 6.7. Rename the menu item that you just created to "Send E-&Mail Using ACT!...
 - 6.8. Drag the "SendFaxUsingAct" macro to the bottom of the "File" menu.
 - 6.9. Right click on the new menu item that you just created to bring up its properties.
 - 6.10. Rename the menu item that you just created to "Send &Fax Using ACT!..."
 - 6.11. Select the "Insert" menu which will drop it down for customizing.
 - 6.12. Drag the "ZActShowFields" macro to the bottom of the "Insert" menu.
 - 6.13. Right click on the new menu item that you just created to bring up its properties.
 - 6.14. Select "Begin New Group".
 - 6.15. Rename the menu item that you just created to "ACT! Mail-Merge Fields..."
 - 6.16. In the "Customize" menu, select "Close".

7. Finish

7.1. Select File->Close and save changes.
